

Report of resurvey of the Robert
Gordon League of land - Situated
in Newton County Texas -

I began at the
N.W. Corner of the E. Shoemaker league
and ran S. 80° W. but found no line
marks that showed to be over twenty or
twenty five years old - at 2400 varas
crossed Nichols Creek at 5275 varas I found
a very old line running N. 10° W. & S. 10° E. I
traced said line N. 10° W. which I found
plainly marked but very old. at 2680 varas
I found a corner that by using a stump
for one of the bearing trees it would fit.
The calls for the N.W. Corner of said
Gordon league - I then traced a very
old line N. 80° E. to a swamp and failed
to find marks any further - I then began
at the S.W. Corner of the J.D. Ray league
and ran S. 80° W. but failed to find any
old line marks - I then began at the
S.W. Corner of said E. Shoemaker league
and ran S. 80° W. and plainly marked old line
and at 1940 varas crossed a marsh slough
that might have been called a creek at
5275 varas stopped in the west side of a
marsh about 25 varas from edge of pine
timber - but found no corner trees, most of
the old timber being dead & rotten -

I then ran N. 10° W. at 2400 varas
reached the point where I struck
said old line when I ran S. 80° W. found N.W.
corner of said Shoemaker league
