

Statement concerning Conflict of  
Block 64 H & T.C. R.R. Co. with Blocks 5  
and X. Texas & Pacific R.R. Co. -

Nolan and Taylor Counties. I find  
N.E. cor. of 290 and N.E. cor. 291 block 64  
both are identified as original location  
corners. From N.E. corner of No 290.

I established corner every 1900 ft. going  
west for six miles. as shown on  
sketch in red ink. The S.E. and  
S.W. corners of Sur 36 block 5 Texas  
and Pacific R.R. are both old st.  
mds. identified by stumps of original  
bearing trees. From S.W. corner of Sur.  
36 block 5. I ran West to S.E. corner  
of Sec. 42 block 5 T&P. as made many  
years ago by C. Surveyor of Nolan  
County — Weatherby said corner  
is a st. md. which I adopted.

From this st. md. a st. md. made by  
W.C. Breedlove brs S36 E & West 3.4<sup>0</sup>  
For distances see red ink figures  
on sketch representing lines actually  
measured on ground. No 311 block 64  
H & T.C. R.R. Co. conflict with no 110.

block X Texas & Pacific and the W.C.  
Breedlove Survey. as shown on the  
sketch. No 110. T&P. is identified by  
stone mds. and original bearing trees  
The S. line of Sur. 36 block 5 T&P.R.R. Co. is not  
a true East & West line but is off in  
course 1° being 88<sup>9</sup> W. - I find enough

evidence on the ground to the original location  
of Surveys 31 and 34 & 37. Distance North  
from S.W. corner 35 (original corner) to S. line  
of 34 is 1746 varas instead of 1650 as  
per original field notes, or an excess  
of 196 varas. Surveys 35 and 36 have been  
improved & fenced including this excess.  
Surveys 39 & 41 have been surveyed from  
S.W. corner of Survey 36 and do not include  
this excess. Surveys 38, 40 & 43 have for  
their S. lines a continuation of lines of  
Surveys 31, 34 & 37 and do not include this  
excess, and are so improved on the ground.  
Surveys 39 & 41 do not call for surveys S. of them. Surveys  
38, 40 & 43 do not call for surveys S. of them, hence  
this strip of land is not covered by block 50  
But is covered by surveys 313, 314, 315 & 316  
Block 64 H & T.C. RR Co. Also parts of Surveys  
312 & 313, lying W. of Sur. 42 block 50 & E. of  
Survey 110 block X. Texas & Pacific are not  
in conflict with patented surveys, so far  
as I know. The corrections of surveys 295  
296, 303, 302, 301, 300, 299, 298, 297, 296, 295  
etc from S.W. corners of Sur. 295 and N.E. cor.  
of 296 both corners were established by  
Stephen Turner in 1886


