In correcting Surveys 189 & 190, block.
64. N & T. C. R. R. Co. in Nolan County
I recognized the resurvey made by
Stephen Turner in year 1886
County Surveyor Weatherby when he
surveyed the E. Hylton preemption did
not respect the Turner work, but put
in corners of his own, putting N.W.
corner of the Hylton survey 30 varas
in conflict with 189. He also moved
S.W. corner of 188 - 30 varas N. of Turner's
corner. I reset S.W. corner of 188 to the
point where Turner established it
(both of the bearing trees are standing
I let the N. line of the Hylton Survey
remain where Weatherby placed it
which is the position held by the
Hylton patent, making W. line of
No 189. - 920 v. long instead of 950
varas. as made by Turner. The Hylton
Survey is held on ground by bearing
trees; and long occupancy, by the
Hylton family, of this survey, fixes
its lines by limitation, so far as
No 189. a senior survey, is concerned
I recognized the Pedro Martinez sur-
as it has been placed on the ground

for many years. And as recognized by Weatherly in making the Hyllton and other settler surveys, adjoining it. There is an old fence on N line of the Martinez survey. This fence is at right angle to West line of the Martinez survey. I established N.E. corner of the Martinez survey. course & distance from its N.W. corner as placed in Hyllton patent. I also file with this report a sketch of this work, which also shows connection between blocks 1A. and 64 N & Y.C. R.R. - Nos 206 & 207 block 64 conflict with Nos 30 & 31 block 1A. as shown on said sketch.
