The State of Texas.  Survey No. 342.  
 County of Nueces  Fieldnotes of a survey of portions  
 of Harbor and Mustang Islands, Turtle Cove and  
 a portion of Corpus Christi Bay, made for "The  
 Port Aransas Company" under the directions  
 of E. N. Roper, President, in accordance with Chapter  
 100, General Laws of the State of Texas, passed  
 at the Regular Session of the Twentieth Legislature  
 and entitled, "An Act to amend Title 20. of the  
 counter 32530

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Mueces Co. St. Fil #126

Revised Civil Statute of the State of Texas, entitled Private Corporations, by adding another Chapter thereto, to be styled Chapter Fourteen, authorizing the construction, owning, and operating deep water Channels and docks.

Said Survey is No 342 in Mueces County, situated in Mueces and Aransas Counties, on the waters of the Gulf of Mexico, Corpus Christi, and Aransas Bays, about 20 miles N 80° E. of Corpus Christi.

Beginning at a pine stake marked "O", about 50 rods North of the large bayou immediately South of the Aransas Pass Light House, and about 60 rods West of the Eastern margin of Harbor Island, whence the N.E. Corner of Survey No 22 in the name of Elizabeth Tally made by virtue of Head Right Certificate No <sup>5031</sup>/<sub>5032</sub> bears N 29° 14' W. 12500.7 rods; Aransas Pass Light House bearing N 59° 48' W. 148 rods, thence at shell bank bearing N 17° 45' W. Thence S 21° 15' W. 447 rods to a stake marked P, at water's edge for a corner of this survey, Thence S 00° 50' W. 2484.3 rods across waters of Aransas Harbor to a stake marked Q at the southern extremity of Western wing of Apur constructed by the United States Government Engineer, at the head of Mustang Island, for a corner of this Survey, Thence with the meanders of Mustang Island beach S 56° 10' E. 216 rods; S 51° 30' E. 313 rods; S 62° 15' E. 288 rods; S 51° 45' E. 343 rods; S 14° E. 328 rods; S 49° 45' W. 529 rods; S 42° 15' W. 703 rods; S 39° 40' W. 1046 rods; S 39° 25' W. 888 rods set a stake marked R for the S.E. Corner of this Survey, Thence S 82° 50' W. across Mustang Island 5500 rods to the margin of Corpus Christi Bay at Stake Z for the S.W. Corner of this Survey, Thence

with the margin of said Corpus Christi Bay  $N 7^{\circ} 15'$   
 $N. 2360$  rods, set a Stake No 1 for a corner of this  
Survey; Thence  $N 4^{\circ} 24' E.$  across a portion of Corpus  
Christi Bay aforesaid  $3935$  rods to the western point of  
Hart's Island aforesaid, set Stake No 2, for a corner  
of this Survey; Thence with the margin of Corpus Christi  
Bay aforesaid,  $N 27^{\circ} E. 1116$  rods;  $N 49^{\circ} 30' E. 3276$  rods;  
 $N 14^{\circ} 35' E. 1782$  rods to Stake marked  $x$  on margin  
of Corpus Christi Bay aforesaid, for the N.W. corner of this  
Survey; Thence East, at  $227$  rods set Stake  $G$ ,  
where Light House aforesaid bears  $S 37^{\circ} 48' E.$  at  
 $3741$  rods set Stake  $D$  about  $50$  rods west of the  
Eastern margin of Hart's Island aforesaid for the W.  
corner of this Survey, where the aforesaid Light House  
bears  $S 6^{\circ} 49' W.$  Thence  $S 14^{\circ} 38' E. 613$  rods set Stake  
 $C$ , about  $60$  rods West of Eastern margin of Hart's  
Island aforesaid for a corner of this Survey; Thence  $S 14^{\circ}$   
 $12' E. 342$  rods set Stake  $B$  about  $60$  rods West of the  
Eastern margin of Hart's Island aforesaid, for a corner  
of this Survey; Thence  $S 6^{\circ} E. 252$  rods set Stake  $H$   
about  $60$  rods West of Eastern margin of Hart's Island  
aforesaid, for a corner of this Survey; Thence  $S 4^{\circ} 10' E. 355$   
rods set Stake  $F$ , about  $60$  rods West of Eastern margin  
of Hart's Island aforesaid for a corner of this Survey;  
Thence  $S 5^{\circ} 12' W. 355$  rods set Stake  $K$  about  $60$  rods  
West of Eastern margin of Hart's Island aforesaid  
for a corner of this Survey; Thence  $S 8^{\circ} W. 894$  rods  
set Stake "116" about  $60$  rods West of Eastern  
margin of Hart's Island aforesaid, for a corner  
of this Survey; Thence  $S 15^{\circ} 10' W. 756$  rods set  
Stake  $N$ , about  $60$  rods West of the Eastern  
margin of Hart's Island aforesaid, for a corner

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of this survey. Thence S 25° 30' W. 602 varas to the place  
of beginning.
