Dear Sir:

I have your application of inquiry of the 10th instant relative to the existence of supposed vacant lands in Nueces County, which you describe as being three small islands in the mouth of Oso creek lying about 5 miles Southeast of Corpus Christi. You further designate these tracts as lying between two grants of land known as El Rincon del Oso and El Rincon de Corpus Christi. I find that the areas mentioned are properly and legally a part of the Rincon del Oso grant titled to Enrique Villareal on November 18, 1834, according to its field notes. Under the above circumstances, I must advise that no vacancy exists. My telegram of this morning explains the reason that reference to your application of inquiry was not made in my letter to Mr. O'Neill.

For Mr. O'Neill's information I am sending a copy of this letter to him that he may be advised of your inquiry and reply thereto.

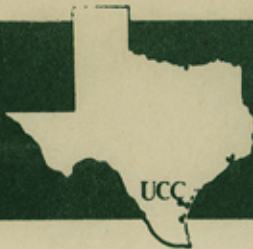
