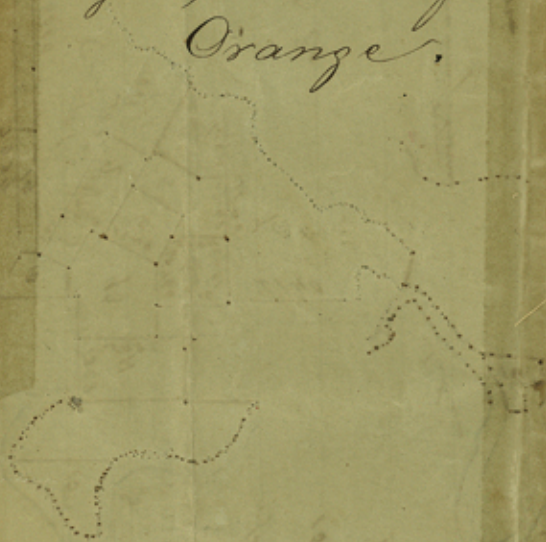
Plot of Adam's B. & Sabine R.
