W. C. Jackson. In this the maps in the G. L. O. are in  
error. I send you amended field notes of Sec 25. Block  
3 which shows the true position of the W. C. Jackson  
survey.

The certificate was not filed in P. P. land office, but I  
have field noted the survey out as it is the oldest &  
survey west of the Brazos. having been settled some years  
before the settlement by sections of surveys near it in  
name B. B. B. & C. R. R. & S. A. & W. G. R. R.

New survey Sec 42, 43. conflict with John Stephens Survey 480 acres.  
I send certificate of W. C. Powell showing that certificate  
in which this survey was based has been lifted &  
relocated as shown. This statement I suppose can  
be easily verified in the G. L. O. as I see that one of  
the surveys referred to is plotted on our copy of Stephens  
Co map.
