Dear Sir,

I wish to hereby certify
that in making surveys for the
Texas Pacific Railway Co. in
Parker Co. I discovered the
following errors in the maps
and field notes of several surveys
as follows, viz

1st That the Thos. Jackson and
the J. A. Hopkins surveys do not
connect with the J. F. Earnest
as shown on map, but with the
J. Woosley survey, and the location
of said surveys as shown on my
plat. of Block No 2. T & P Ry Co's
land is correct, and that the
D. E. Adleman survey shown in
Block 2 is not where the field
notes would locate it, but is where
shown on my plat.

2nd That Survey No 5 Block No 1
will not conflict with any survey
on the South of it said survey
being situated much further South,
than is shown on map.

3rd That Both the Bay
Stepenson, and the Ant Sierra
surveys, are situated both North
and East of where shown on map
and no surveys made by me for
the Texas and Pacific Railway Co
can conflict with of them, as
shown on plat of Block 6, T & P
Railway Co's land.
