

Weatherford, Parker County, Texas.
October the 17th 1859

Mr Francis M White commissioner of the
General Land Office at Austin Texas
Dear Sir, from the calls of the J J Shaw
Survey, the SE corner of said Survey is 2800
varas N60E from the NW corner of the
Leon County School Land. The SE corner
of the A H Onstott 53 acre Survey
is 10 varas S60W from said Shaw's
NE corner. The SW corner of the
James A Yeoman 80 acre Survey is
201 varas N76E from the J J Stroud's
SE corner and the A H Onstott's NE
corner lies somewhere near half way between said
Stroud's SE corner and said Yeoman's SW
corner. This last item I ascertained from
my own observation, so that the SE corner
of the James A Yeoman 80 acre Survey
could not extend along in the same
direction with the Northwestern boundary line
of the Leon County School Land more
than ^{from the NW corner of said Leon County School Land} 3572 varas. And again the
SE corner of the Jesse Thomas 320
acre Survey is N30W from the NE
corner of said Leon County School Land
and the South East boundary of said Jesse
Thomas extends from its SE corner S60W
950 varas, and the Davis Lewisell Survey
extends in the same direction about 750 varas
Southwest of said Jesse Thomas SW
corner, and the Wyatt Williams Survey
extends S60W 475 varas from said
Lewisell's SW corner, so that the

corner of the Wyatt Williams Survey
cannot extend along the NW boundary
of said Leon County School Land, in a
direction N⁶⁰W more than about 2175
varas, ^{from the NW corner of said Leon County School Land} consequently there must necessarily
be left a space of about 800 varas
between the western boundary of the Wyatt
Williams and the Eastern boundary of the
James & Yeoman surveys. I have not
the slightest idea that they conflict.
