

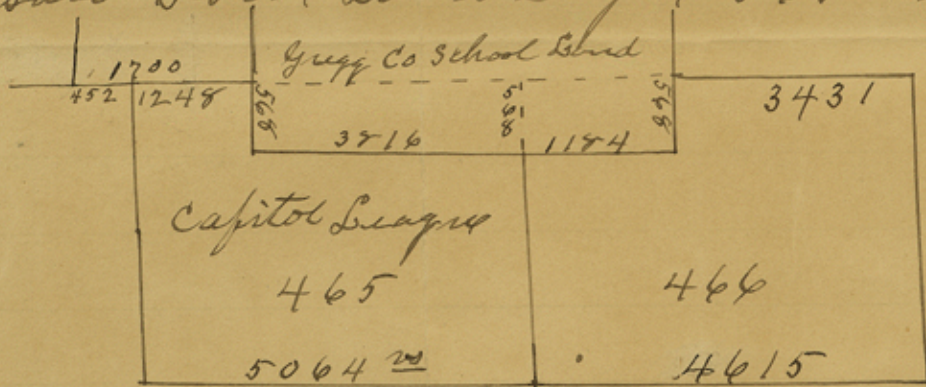

In connection with the field notes of certain surveys made by Mr. G. R. Jewell, co. surveyor of Deaf Smith county, adjoining Capitol leagues 466 & 467, I respectfully submit the following statement of a resurvey of Capitol leagues Nos 465-466-467-468 and Gregg Co. School Land League No 2<sub>N</sub> <sup>made by me</sup> for the Capitol Syndicate Co. I find that Capitol league No 465 conflicts with said School Land League 568<sup>th</sup> North, and 3816<sup>th</sup> East. and Capitol <sup>League</sup> No 466 conflicts with said School Land League 568<sup>th</sup> North and 1184<sup>th</sup> East



I also find that a line projected North from the S.W. cor of Capitol league No 468 falls 452 varas East of a line pro-

jected South from the N.E. corner of Capitol league No 444. Both corners well identified. distance 20,085<sup>th</sup>. No intermediate cor. found.

Dear Sir - Find herewith inclosed field notes of 19 surveys in Blk. B. in Parmen, Castro & Deaf Smith counties - I find and identify by course and distance from the original Summerfield monument in S.W. cor. sur. 131 block M 7. and the N.S. Mabry survey in the N. border of said block, and the original corners in N.E. N.W. & S.E. corners of Buff Co. League no. 1, and the original cor. in N.E. cor. of Buff Co. league no 2 - I say that I have measured course and distance from the old corners and found and identified the N.E. cor. Capital League 444 and the S.W. cor. of league 467 and 468 - and find the two last named cor. about 500 yds. too far E. to correspond with the N.E. cor. of league 444 - I can offer no satisfactory theory to account for this condition - I inclose herewith a sketch and statement from Capt. A.S. Howren - which I hope will be of use to your office in considering these papers - Your office has refused to pass on my work as correct, for the reason that it does not agree with J.H. Fleming's work on vacant land between sur. 166 Blk. M7. on the E. and Capital League no. 467 on the W. I beg to suggest that my work N. N. and E. of Buff Co. league no. 2 does not necessarily agree with Fleming's work referred to - Permit me to call your attention to the distance E. & W. from Blk. M7 to Capital League 444, as indicated by the intervening surveys - and compare my work with this distance, as shown
