

Survey made July 26-1900.

Began at a stone md. on point of a hill N.W. of Longfellow station; Cap rock marked "H". Said stone md being identified as the original ^{N.E.} Corner section 18, Blk 156.

Thence West 100 varas. - Thence North 1600 vrs. - Thence West 1800 varas. - Thence North 300 vrs. - Thence ^{N. 45° W} 1344 varas. - Thence West 950 varas. - Thence N 45° West 1344 varas. - Thence North 335 varas. - Thence North 45° West 500 varas. - Thence North 80 vrs. - Thence N 45° W 844 vrs. - Thence North 535 vrs. - Thence West 804 vrs. - Thence N 45° W 2688 vrs. - Thence North 1900 vrs. - Thence N 45° W 2688 vrs. to point for N.W. Corner sec. 56 Blk "R4".

Began again at a large stone md. marked S.E. 26. Identified as S.E. Corner survey 26 in N.G. Ry. Co Blk. No. 1.

Thence South 1900 varas. - Thence West 500 varas. - Thence South 495 varas. - Thence West 80 vrs. - Thence South 1405 vrs. - Thence West 370 vrs. to point for S.E. Corner sec. 14 Blk. 1. I.C. Ry. Co.

Thence East 981 varas and South 370 varas to the point marked for N.W. Corner sec. 56 Blk "R4".
