Mode of survey

Transit, hub line, doulble centering on each line and 100 vara steel tape.

The survey that I made envolved river surveys from 32 North to the N.E. corner of survey 43 Block 1, I. & G.N.Ry. Co.; Block 193 Tex. Mex. Ry. Co.; Block A 2, T.C.Ry.Co.; and Block B 2, C.C.S.D. & R.G.N.G.Ry.Co, Pecos and Terrell Counties.

I ran a connection line from the S.E. corner of survey No. 32 (which corner has been heretofore identified by me as the original corner and shown on my map) to the N.E. corner of survey No. 37, commonly known as the Pecos Spring corner. This corner I located 200 varas North of a stone mound marked I R (shown on my may).

Jacob Kuechler, the original surveyor, described this corner as a Hackberry marked X and in his field book he says: Thence South, at 200 varas a stone mound marked I R, from which a 5" cedar brs. S. 10 E. 10 varas. There is only one cedar of any size in this vicinity and it is now about i4" in diameter and bears S. 5°W. 9.4 varas from the stone mound, which seems to indicate that the Surveyor must have guessed at the course and probaly stepped the distance.

A position 200 varas North of this corner, however fits the loaction of the Pecos Spring corner as generally accepted.

I gave all the surveys between the above mentioned corners their field note call distances North and South, with the exception of the John M. Swisher survey No. $35\frac{1}{2}$ which was put in by O.W.Williams in 1892, and which latter survey had left for a North and South distance only 438.5 varas.

Going West on the South line of these surveys from the West bank of the Pecos river I gave them their field note calls which is in accordance with the Land Office construction heretofore used.

I also ran a travers North from the Pecos Spring corner to the N.E. corner of survey No. 43, which has been generally accepted as the original corner, giving surveys 536, 535, 5362 and 38 their field notes calls North and South. I then prorated the excess North and South among surveys 39, 40, 41, 42 and 43, <u>giving them</u>, and giving them their field note calls going West on their South lines from the West bank of the Pecos river.

All surveys in Blocks A 2 and B 2 were put in in accordance with my map of that area filed with the General Land Office and Dated Sept. 26, 1936.

I used the same line for a North Course as was used in the Whiteside case for Blocks A 2, B 2 and 193, which is 0°17' to the right of a North course and for the river surveys I used a line 0°40' to the Right of a North Course, this latter line I checked off the original Surveyor's call for bluffs on river to bear N. 19 45' W., which call in his field book is as follows:

At the S.E. corner of survey No. 37. Thence S at 560 vs Bluffs on river br N 19 $\frac{3}{4}$ W) at 580 vs cross creek, at 950 vs. stone md. mkd I R a hackberry 4 near road brs S. 52 $\frac{3}{4}$ W 80 vs.

I have made corrected field notes for surveys 1 and 2 Block 193, Tex. Mex. Ry.Co., tieing them to the river surveys on the East as shown on the map which I am sending you.
