REFERRED TO MAP

Referring to your letter of August 11 addressed to Geo. T. Wilson of this City, your letter of the 7th of October addressed to me, and a copy of J.H. Walker letter to you dated October 7th.

All of above letters pertaining to the construction of Blocks 16, 17, and 18 University Land in Pecos County.

I extended my survey of 1941 from the N.W. corner of Sur. 84 Blk. 194, G.C. & S.F.R.R.Co. (using A.N.Lea line) North to the N.E. corner of Block 16 and as I wrote you on the 21st of September I located on the ground the N.E. corner of Blk. 16 approximately 48.1 vrs. East and 70.7 vrs. North of the F.F.Friend N.E. corner of Blk. 16.

According to your instructions I have located the East line of Block 16 as follows: Using the Friend corner on the ground for the N.E. corner of Blk. 16 and a point 98.5 vrs. South and 270.8 vrs. West of the Friend corner on the ground for the S.E. corner of survey 36 Blk. 16.

According to my survey this line would take a course S. 1°49' W. and from this latter point for the S.E. corner of survey 36 I ran a traverse along the A.N.Lea line N. 1°56'50" E. to the South side of the Old Spanish Trail.

Thence with the South side of the Old Spanish Trail Westerly to a point near the West line of survey 31 Blk. 16 as located by Mr. Friend.

Thence along the Friend West line of Blks. 16 and 17 University Land, South to a point 285 vrs. East of an Old Stone mound on the North side of a Hill for the S.E. corner of Blk. 18. The same stone mound as found by me in 1926.

About the only difference in my survey and the Friend survey is our North, which according to my survey would make the Friend North to actually be N. 0°29' E. North was taken off Baker Station, which is located in the Southwest part of Sec. 32 T.C.Ry.Co, Blk. Z.
