Your favor in reply to my letter and report was duly received and I write to thank you for attending to the account and your kind reference to work in this part of the country.

I have made arrangements with Mr. E. E. Townsend of the Elsinore Cattle Co. Pecos Co. to complete the resurvey of their lands in Blks. A, B, C, & D in Pecos Co.

I already have your instructions for this work under my general appointment as State Surveyor and I suppose that will be all that is necessary. The work was begun and a report of progress returned, and your instructions in the premisses received, so that all that remained was to mark the corners and lines. This was partly done when dry weather and Mr. Townsends convenience called a halt. He is now ready to go ahead and complete the survey, and I will go out there in a few days.

There are several other applications for work in the County and one of them will settle the disputed line near San Diego Mountain.

I want to thank you again for your kindness in having me appointed on the Syndicate Resurvey, and to assure you that I would have stayed with the work if it had been possible for me to have to done the work as I thought it should be done.
