Dear Sir,

Herewith inclosed is corrected Field Notes on Survey 30 Block 129 Texas & St. Louis Ry. Co. in Pecos County, Texas for your approval.

I began this Survey at the North West Corner of Survey 10, Block 101, as set by Mr. Geo. M. Williams and then ran West over N.W. Corner Survey 15 and N.W. of 22 with 8 vrs. excess over this 2 miles, and one West 2 miles 1900 vrs each, and then turned a 90 degree angle on North 1914.8 vrs to the original corner as set by L.W. Durrel and recognized by Geo. M. Williams as such, and being the N.W. Corner of 37 Block 101.

I then returned to my turning point North and extended this line South 3 miles or 1877.7 vrs. to the mile and 2 miles further South at 1900 vrs to the mile as per the East line of Survey 6 Block 128 Texas & St. Louis Ry. Co. and the East Line of Survey 45 Block 102 John H. Gibson as set by Geo. M. Williams. At said 5 mile corner South turned East 2 miles or 3800 vrs. and here made a Corner S.E. 1, Block 130 and N.W. 7 Block 129 Texas & St. Louis Ry. Co. Thence South 5 miles or the first 3 miles of this Southing is 1922.3 vrs. to the mile and the last two miles are 1900 vrs. each as to compare with the East Lines of Surveys 27 and 34 in Block 128 Texas & St. Louis Ry. Co. as set by Geo. M. Williams. Here, turned East for connecting on South East Corner of 34 Block 128, this run gave me 1903.9 vrs for the first mile, 1904.1 vrs for second mile, this is the same as the North Line of 22 and 15 of Block 101, thus continuing East 1916.30 vrs per mile for five miles as seven miles East or to a point South of S.E. 1 of Survey 6 Block 128, thus the excess is divided as found, on East three miles at 1882.17 vrs per mile to corner set by Geo. M. Williams at the South East of 34, Block 128.

This work has been rechecked as per your requested on work reported to your office July 18th, 1927.

Mr. Geo. M. Williams work which is dated in 1906 he did some Traverse lines which I find to be excessive East and South, and short North and West, this is the result of my work recognizing his corners which are acceptable by the Ranch Owners and also accepted by me.
