

To his N Corner I found that the error was there only
and in correcting the Luther B. Porter's preemption Survey I
then ascertained the fact that the North and South line of the
Augustine's league Survey was 5000 yds Each otherwise the Morland
League would not correspond with the L B Porter and all
the Survey South of them.

I never have yet run the John D. Nash Survey completely
I have only run the N E corner and the W corner and the
line between them which is 6000 yds long from beginning
line below the beginning point of the Castaneda and L B Porter
league Survey, and as one of the corners is immediately on the
Bank of Menards Creek it will settle that league where it
will settle you only two sides of that league been run on
the ground.

I can not do any more Survey at this time for the want
of Chain-man and provisions until the Crops be through
and provisions Easy

I had once more and hope to be the last time that the
School land survey has decided me on the basis the
true line of the Cone league Survey never been run but the Corners
South & West are satisfactory proof, the Field Notes of the
Medina Gate league Survey and the Field Notes of the Pancom
Wilburn, both make their Beginning Corner at the West Corner
of the said 1st Cone, therefore, will have for his South Corner
the most West Corner of Thomas Colville. Mr Gardner wish to know
as soon he can pay for his preemption.
