for Polk County do hereby certify that the sketch contained on this sheet of paper represents the true positions of Hampton, Falcon, Colville and Escobedo leagues of land in relation to each other as found to exist by actual observation on the ground. The North corner of the

Hampton league called in the Escobedo field notes the North West corner bearing trees of which are a black oak 20 inches diameter bears S. 47 E. distant 7 varas and a white oak 15 inches diameter bears S 1/2 W distant 4 varas is the South corner according to the field notes of the Escobedo league the white oak about 17 or 18 inches diameter (at the time I examined) is still standing evidencing the fact

And the Beginning and East corner of the Falcon league lies North 45° West 1000 varas from the South corner of the Escobedo and is common to the Falcon and Colville leagues
