State of Texas. Field notes of a resurvey of  
 County of Polk. the Garrison E. Watson League  
 of Land, situated in Polk County Texas on  
 the waters of Big Sandy Creek, tributary of  
 the Neches river about 15 miles S.E. from  
 the Town of Livingston.

Beginning at the S. W. or most southern corner  
 of the Lowry J. Hampton League, which calls  
 for the same bearing trees that the Garrison  
 E. Watson calls for, which Lowry J. Hampton  
 was formerly known by the name of Thosene  
 League. Thence N 45° W with said Hampton's  
 S.W. boundary line at 2320 on a prong of Double  
 Branch at 5000 varas I found old lines intersecting  
 whence a white oak now 15 in dia bears N 48° 15'  
 varas, plainly marked and marks very old,  
 from same point at N 31° E 1900. dia is the marks  
 where a tree once stood now bearing tree marked  
 by me a White Oak 16 in dia from N 44° W 14000., a  
 Hickory 8 in dia bears N 87° W 14000. a Hickory 6 in  
 dia bears N 93° W 8000 all m.kd X. Thence S 45° W  
 with an old line well marked at 4000 on main  
 prong of Double Branch at 1600 varas. another  
 prong of said branch, at 2450 a small ravine  
 at 2600 on a road at this point I ceased to find  
 the old line marks, at 4030 a small branch, at  
 4960 on a small Spring branch at 5000 on I found  
 no signs of an old cor or lines. set stake from  
 whence a Pine 22 inches dia brs S 71° W 5000  
 another 18 in. dia brs S 85° E 000 also a white oak 10 in  
 dia brs S 54° E 10000 all marked X Thence S 45° E at  
 200 varas a Spring bog at 10000 on a small branch  
 in open piney woods at 1770 a Spring branch at  
 2100 a. Spring branch at 5000 on set stake. whence  
 a sweet gum 18 in dia brs S 70° E 22000 another 15 in

dia brs. S 85° W 2400 also a Point 12 in six bears &  
3888 vs all marked & I found no old line on this  
course. Thence N 45° E 5000 vs to the beginning.  
Survey finished January 1<sup>st</sup> 1887.
