Field notes of the Juan Simon Lazarin
league. Situated on the east side of
of the Trinity river on Big Sandy creek
and on the road leading from Nacogdoches
to the lower Coahuila town,

Beginning at the NE cor. of Dr Brownrigg's
survey, Thence N 45° E 5000 varas were
measured to the second corner
formed with an earth mound
around a stake from which a Black
oak 18 in. in dia. bears south 80°
distant and a Pine 12 inches in diameter
S 18° W 1600 distant - Thence S 45° E
5000 varas, were measured to a Post oak
8 inches in diameter for the 3rd corner
from which a Mulberry tree 11 inches
in diameter bears N 83° W 1600 distant
and a Black oak 16 inches in diameter br.
N 12° E 2000 distant -

Thence S 45° W 5012 were measured
to the SE cor. of Dr Brownrigg's survey
and thence with the line of said
survey N 45° W 5000 were measured
to the first corner

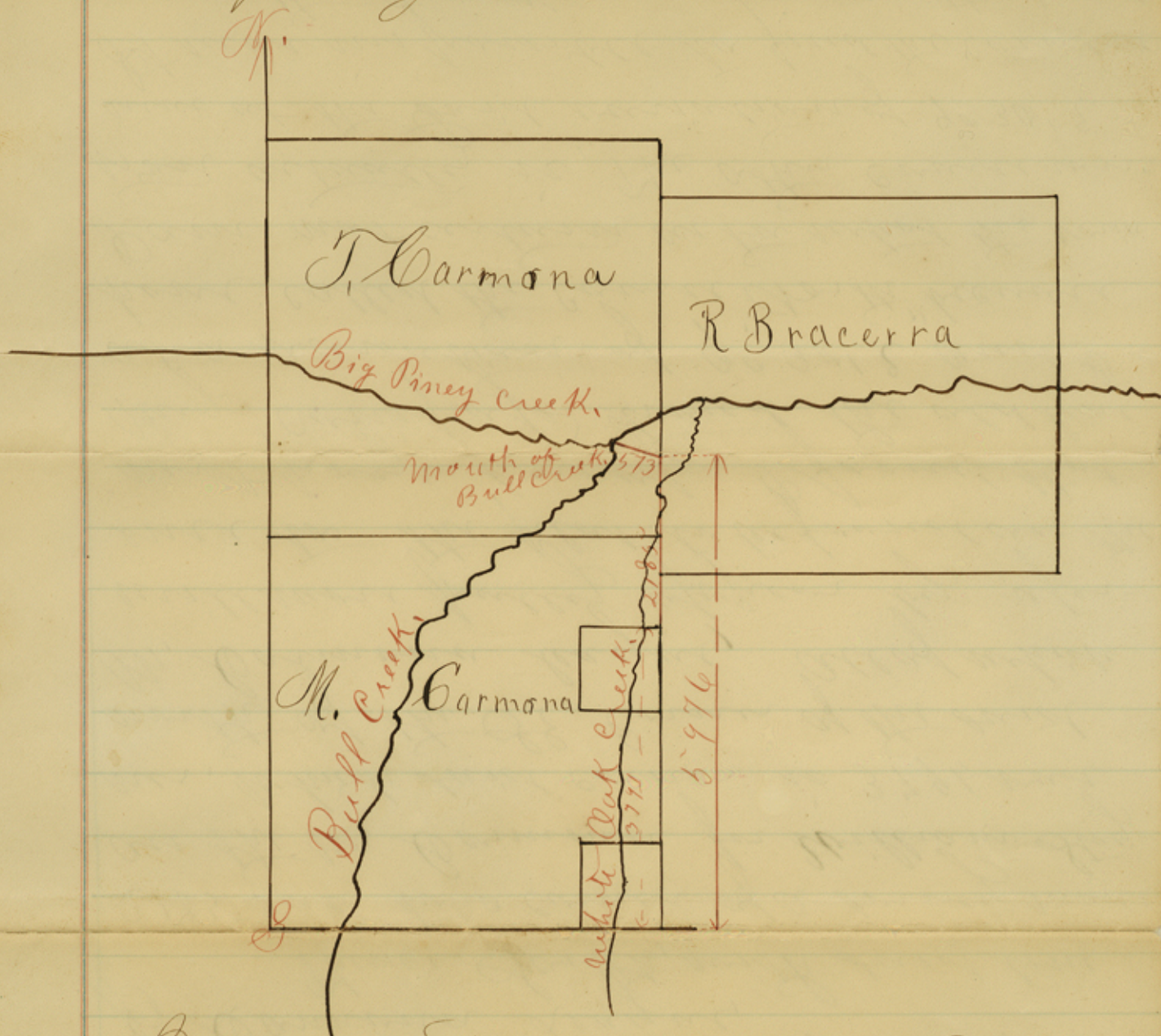

Permit me to make to you my
report of the survey made by me to
connect the mouth of Bull Creek on
line between said county and ~~Trinity~~
county of said state with the league
surveys in said county.

Beginning at the mouth of Bull
Creek, Thence S. $60^{\circ}30'E$ at 573 varas
intersects the East boundary line of the
M. Comona League,

Thence South, with said line
2185 varas to a corner of a survey made
on the M. Comona for William Stug-
ner, which said corner is 3791 varas
north of the S.E. Corner of the said
M. Comona league, All of which
will more fully appear by refer-
ence to the plat to be found on the
next page hereof. I found that
my compass showed the old line
at a variation of $90^{\circ}30'E$ and I
have called the course "North" because
I am not certain as to what the varia-
tion actually is, The other course run
was at the said variation of $90^{\circ}30'E$
It was impossible to find the corner
near the creek, owing to the fact
that the marks have been obliterated
and many trees have fallen it was
counter 34191

hence deemed best to take the S.E. Corner of the M. Carmona, which could be definitely ascertained
