State of Texas } Field notes of a  
County of Polk } resurvey of the John  
Maginnis league of land, situated  
in Polk County Texas, on the waters  
of McMannus creek, of the Neches  
river, about three miles N.E. of the  
town of Moscow.

Beginning at the N.W. corner of  
the Abner Mardez league, whence  
a pine 20 in. dia. marked with a  
very old blaze brs. S 13 E 21<sup>3</sup>/<sub>10</sub> vs.  
the other witness tree, a pine about 28  
inches in diameter is now fallen down.  
The course and distance of this tree  
corresponds exactly with that given  
in the old original John Maginnis  
field notes; therefore I know this to  
be the old N.E. corner of this league.

+ Thence south at 1410 vs. cross the  
T. & S. rail road, at 4650 vs. a creek  
8 vs. wide, course N.E. at 6760 vs. the  
old bed of a creek, at 6810 vs. the same  
creek as it now runs, at 7500<sup>vs.</sup> to  
S.W. cor. of said Mardez league, or the  
point where the south and west  
lines of said Mardez intersect; there  
is no evidence of the old witness tree  
at this corner, Thence west at  
2473 vs. a creek 8 vs. wide, course N.E.  
at 3333<sup>vs.</sup> corner (There is no descrip-  
tion given at this corner in the old  
Maginnis field notes) Thence  
north 7500 vs. cor. Thence east  
3333 vs. to place of beginning, I found  
all the natural and artificial points  
called for in this league according

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to its old field notes with the exception of the S.E. corner and the distance to the creek on the S.B. line, The old field notes run east on the south line and call for this creek at 680 vs. from the SW cor, I find the creek at 860 vs instead of 680,

having the same figures but differently situated, which I believe to have been a clerical error, as all the other distances I found just as called for, I found a few old line marks on this, the south line, but not so well marked as on the east line, which is plainly marked all the way, I did not find the west line of this league, nearly all the timber on this line had been cut by a saw mill before I found these leagues, Surveyed May 8<sup>th</sup> 1891
