Beginning at the S.E. corner of
said league, which is the beginning
corner of the first survey made
in the year 1830. Both of the original
witness trees one now standing, and
both plainly marked with old
blazes on the sides facing the corner.
a Pine now 18' dia. brs. N40E 2 4/10 vs.
a Pine now 22' dia. brs. N39W 6 vs.
Thence north at 129 vs. I find a
depression in the ground resembling
a place where a tree had been burned
out at the roots many years ago. at
136 vs. a pine 22' in dia marked as
a line tree, a blaze fore and aft
with hacks bars and below said blaze,
at 415 vs. a branch course westward
at 2690 branch 5 vs. wide course West
at 3040 vs. intersected the S.W. B. line of
David Cutts league at 4790 vs.
found a gum now 17' dia. mark as
a line tree marks very old can
be plainly seen on both sides of the
tree, at 5000 vs. creek 8 vs wide course
westward at 6550 vs. intersected the
N.W. B. line of said Cutts league, at
7500 corner. This entire line is well
and plainly marked, with old blazes
The same kind as all other old league

lines are marked in this country. The witness trees for this corner the NE one gone, & Thence west at 10500, a spring branch one our wide course SW at 6000, a farm has been cleared, consequently the hickory mentioned in the original field notes, has been destroyed, at 10500, a large creek (McMannus), 1500 wide runs north. at 1305 a creek or branch 500 wide runs north at 33800, found original NW corner (This line is very plainly marked as the other, where there is pine timber.) Pine now 20' dia bro. S 13 E 21³/₁₀00. Pine 28' dia bro. N 22 W 16⁷/₁₀00. The smaller of these two pines is now standing and distinctly shows the old marks, the other has very recently fallen down, and fell in such a position that the marks can not be seen but the size, course and distance exactly corresponds with that given in the old field notes. Thence south at 14100, cross T. & S. railroad, at 46500 creek 800 wide course NE at 67600 old bed of a creek at 68100 The ^{same} creek as it now runs at 75000 corner. The description of the old original corner here was two small trees 4 in dia. They can not now be found. The present growth of timber at this point is small and no indications of large trees remain. This line the west boundary is well and plainly marked all the way. All the lines around this league are plainly marked

and easy to follow, and are very old marks showing to be as old as any league marks in the county,

Thence East at 1555 on cross said McMannus creek 1500 wide course north at 2150 a branch 200 wide course north at 3265 branch 300 wide course north, at 3380 the beginning corner,

From the N.E. corner of this league Thence west at 18000 is the N.E. cor. of S.O. or J. H. Parsons 160 acre survey. It is the N.E. corner of the most northern Parsons survey of the three Parsons surveys that join each other north and south as shown on the county map of Polk county

This is the only connection that I have made with the ~~Morley~~ league, so as to show where it is on the ground, See sketch giving connections on opposite side of this sheet.
