Beginning at S W corner of William Pace on East margin of Trinity river--- Thence down the river with its meanderings S 20 E 600 varas, S 42 W 750 varas, S 10 W 460 varas, N 80 E 900 varas to N W corner of H B Prentiss 7 leagues, 2nd corner---- Thence N 60 E following the North line of the Prentiss 5060 varas to a point where said line intersects the Southern line of the Pace league, 3rd corner--- Thence West with the Southern line of the Pace league 5500 varas to the place of beginning.

Beginning on the East bank of Trinity river at the mouth of a small gulley about one mile above the mouth of Long Kings creek, from which an ash 30 in dia brs N 72 W 22 vrs, a gum 32 in dia brs N 12-30' E 11.7 vrs, also a white oak 12 in dia N 33-30 E 2.9 vrs--- Thence with the meanders of the river as follows: N 37 W 180 vrs, S 72 W 500 vrs, N 33 W 120 vrs, N 31 E 330 vrs, North 210 vrs, N 45 E 170 vrs, N 19 E 200 vrs, N 46 W 800 vrs, N 70 W 500 vrs, N 30 W 460 vrs, N 46 E 700 vrs to 2nd corner from which a cotton wood tree 18 in dia brs S 45 W 10.1 vrs, also a cotton tree 12 in dia brs S 30 W 14.5 vrs--

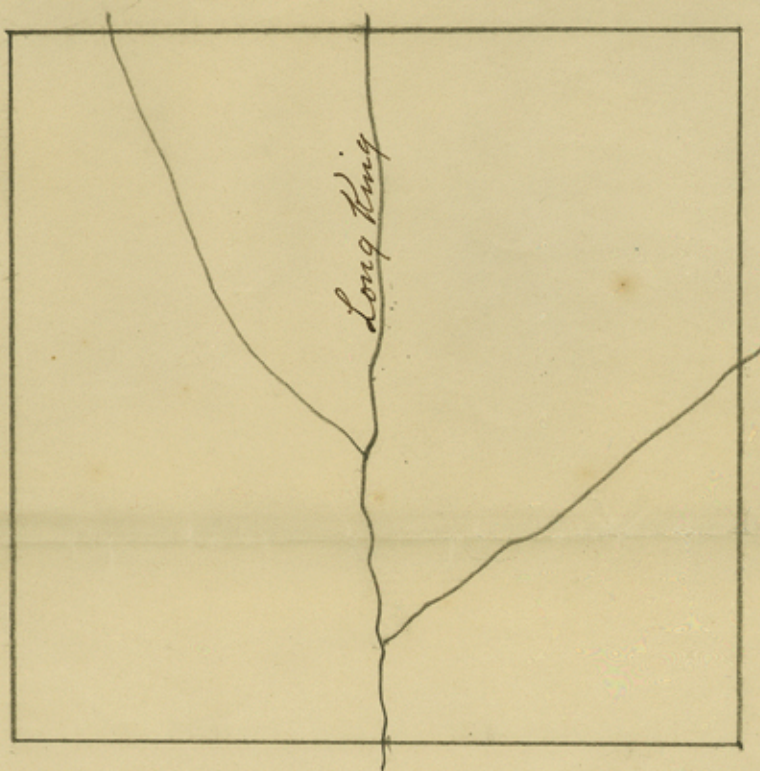

MOSES L. CHOATE

Field Notes of a league of land surveyed for Mos. L. Choate on the Long Kings Creek. Beginning on the road leading from the Long Kings Village on the Trinity to Nacogdoches, about eight miles from the former place, a mound, from which a White Oak 24 in dia bears N 65 W 32 vrs. dist. and a White Oak 12 in dia brs N 66 E 2-1/10 vrs dist., and also a red oak 18 in dia brs N 12-1/2 E 11 vrs dist.

Thence East 1100 vrs to dry branch and the edge of the cane break, pine timber, 1910 vrs Long Kings creek, oak and ash, hickory and elm timber, 2850 varas over pine woods, 5000 varas mound and stake from which a pine 18 in dia brs N 60-1/2 E 5-4/10 vrs dist., also a pine 24 in dia brs N 16-1/2 E 15 vrs dist; also a pine 15 in dia brs N 88-1/2 W 10-2/10 vrs dist.

Thence South 32.2 varas line tree, 346 varas Spring Branch, pine timber, 1300 varas road leading from Long Kings Village to Alabama Village, 2000 varas spring branch, and cane bottom, 4270 varas large branch, pine timber, 5000 varas mound from a pine 18 in dia brs S 6-1/2 E 30 varas dist., also a Post Oak 14 in dia brs N 4 W 19 vrs dist.

Thence West 990 varas spring branch, pine timber, 1250 varas road as above, pine, oak, and ash timber, 2300 varas large branch and cane bottom, 3990 varas Long Kings creek, 5000 varas mound and 4th corner from which a Black Oak 18 in dia brs N 9 W 7 vrs dist., also a pine 20 in dia brs S 60 W 26-3/10 varas dist.

Thence North on a random line 4978.5 varas fell 18 varas West of the beginning, N E on true line 4978.5 varas to 4 corner. Containing one league of land.
