REPORT OF THE SURVEYOR CANADIAN RIVER, POTTER COUNTY.

Mr.Jerry Sadler, Commissioner, General Land Office, Austin, Texas.

Dear Sir; -

In order to locate the "Gradient Boundary" along the river front of the enclosed surveys, your file 48233,7174;49397,7175;-49597,7176;-7177,53713;- (your letter dated May 9th,inst) I spent seven days tracing said Gradient boundary, and since at that time we had an unusual steady flow of the river, at low water level, we were able to establish the gradient boundary with a high degree of accuracy, according to the comentary of Col.Arthur A.Stiles, as published in January 1952, in Volumn 30 of the Texas Law Review.

At this time of year the Canadian river is usuall dry, but as stated above, we were fortunate to have a well defined flow of water, as well as a well defined "accretion bank";-however at several points along the river, the present gradient boundary is identical with the high cut bank, first on one side of the river bed and then to the other side.

I made ties to several corners established by Mr.J.J. Goodfellow in 1920, and have marked on the enclosed map, (sound enver with a round dot, the corners adentified.
