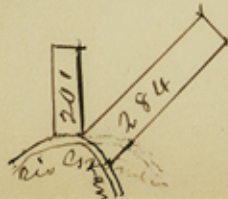
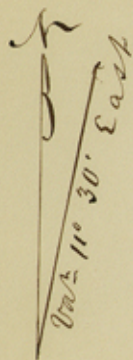

Fieldnotes of a Survey of 320, Three
 Hundred & Twenty Acres of Land ^{made for} Victoriano
 Hernandez. It being the land to which he is
 entitled, by virtue of one half of Land Scrip
 No. 20/33. for 640 acres. issued to the San Antonio
 and Mexican Gulf Railroad Company on the 26th
 day of March 1863. by S. Crosby Commissioner

Said Survey is No. 284 in Presidio County
 and is situated on the waters of the Rio Grande
 about five miles below the town of Presidio del
 Norte Mexico. Beginning at the S.E. Cor of
 Survey No. 201 made for J. S. Burgess, by virtue
 of Land Scrip No. 18/101 issued by S. Crosby Comr.
 July. 25th 1862.

Thence N 45° E. 2688 1/2 ft. to a Stone Mark
 Thence S. 45° E. 672 ft. to a rock mound
 Thence S 45° W. 2688 1/2 ft. to a stake on
 the bank of the river. Thence up the river
 N. 45° W. 672 ft. to the place of beginning.
 Surveyed Dec: 23rd 1872.
