Corrections of surveys in Block one and two T. M. Ry. Co.
September 1907.

Block 1

We found the following original corners on the ground S. E. and S. W. survey 20 also N. E. and S. E. corners survey 18 Block 12 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co., S. E. and S. W. survey 111 and S. W. corner of survey 112 Block 7 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co. N. W. & N. E. Cor. of survey 78 Blk. 5 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co. In connecting all these corners together.

We found that by using a variation of $11^{\circ}44'$ East we ran to all the above corners with this I furnish plat showing all these above corners and Blocks ~~field~~ together with corrected field notes for surveys 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 14, 19, 21, 26, 27, 33, 39, 40 and 38.

Block 2

Thence East 1900 varas passed the N. E. corner of survey 125 and N. W. corner of survey 92 block 12 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co. at 3800 Varas to a rock mound for the N. E. corner of survey 92 from which a boulder in corner of ~~correct~~ brs. N. $67^{\circ}-14'$ E. 480 varas, another boulder in the field brs. N. $75^{\circ}-48'$ E. 351 varas.

This survey in block 2 T. M. Ry. Co. and block 2 T. & P. RY. co. shows as you will note from the Map quite a shortage from the original survey.

This is occasioned by a shortage of 296 varas on the West line of block 12 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co. running from West to East and the surveys from 2 to 10 inclusive block 2 T. & P. Ry. Co. having an excess in width of 925.7 varas or an excess of 91.7 varas in each

The River has washed away all the corners on block 2 T. & P. Ry. Co. except the ones on survey No. 1 and No. 10 block 2 T. & P. Ry. Co. that we surveyed from to equilize the surveys on said block 2 G. H. & S. A. Ry. Co.

We allowed a width of 1041.7 varas for each survey from 2 to 10 inclusive.

Spencer, to the S. W. corner of Survey 5. Block 7. H. & T. C. Ry. Co to ascertain the width of conflict of block 5. at the South end and if Survey 143 and 144 Block 1 D. & P. Ry. Co. are in conflict as shown by the Map of this county. You will find from the survey notes given below that they are not in conflict.
