Dear Sir:

I wrote you a few days ago, regarding Miss Eugenia A. Hector's applications. This mail your letter to her of 12th inst to hand and noted. In regard to same will say that Juan Hernandez bid on No 10, thinking it to be as shown on the blue print map of Presidio Co. date Nov 18th 1895, which shows to be East of 330 cert 460. A.B.M. The late survey by Mr H. W. Brooks County Surveyor, Presidio Co. gives the true position of No 10, which is about 1/2 in conflict with 330 + 468, so do not know whether he will care to keep it or not.

Regarding No 18 Bl 330. I can not locate the John Hardiman survey. (Bexar 3rd class 4741), as it does not appear on the blue print map. I leave for Shafter tomorrow and will report to Miss Hector and have Mr Brooks correct field notes to 18, which is in conflict 290 acres with sur No 9, T. T. R.R. Co.

Herewith I enclose sketch of Mr Brooks survey, which shows true position of all the surveys in that section.

Mr Brooks resides in Shafter, so I will endeavor to get matters fixed at once.

please file this sketch which is marked X.Y.Z with field notes of sur No 18 1/2 Bl 330 made for J.W. Rison. His notes of 18 1/2 & 19 1/2 are corrected and recorded at Marfa and I am only waiting for them to be sent down to be forwarded on to your office. The Deputy is absent from his office at present. I will get the notes next week on my return and send them down.
