lines between corners you desire connected

Note surveys 21 + 22. 160 acres each in name of Hardeman, was located by Mr Favens of Shafter Texas, and he sold to Mr Dawson 20 years ago and still owns and has continued to occupy and has an orchard and irrigated farm on 22. The Mora spring is located in NE corner of 22. and ditch runs from same. These surveys are located on N end of 2. S of S. Bl 23. Dawson also owns 2 + 4. No 2. 1280 conflicts with 21 + 22. and S side of 34 Bl W.T.C. 2.

The connection I have out line runs South from SW cor 21. Bl W.T.C. 2. to SE cor 31. E + S to SW cor 329. a B + 14. E from NW + NE 7. Bl 23. to line in 31. Then S from SW cor 329. to SW cor 330. E to N cor 468. S to its S corner N + S to point 3750. East of beg cor 767. then S. E. to SE cor 510. Then S 71° N E to W cor 489. and South to SW cor 76. F Hernandez.

The Mora creek enters in Cibola, not Cienega
329 + 330 were also located by Favens, all in 1850?
and he opened farms on 329 + 22. Hector

Dear Sir:-

In accordance with your letter of November 1st, to Mr. Hector of Alpine, Texas, concerning a resurvey of certain school surveys in Presidio County applied for by Mr. W. W. Burford, which letter was forwarded to this office by Mr. Hector on the 12th ultimo, you will proceed under your general appointment as State Surveyor, to go upon the ground and make a survey of the territory surrounding and including the following surveys in Presidio County, viz: Survey No. 18, Block 330, 640 Acres, TCRyCo, Survey No. 28, Block 330, 1297 acres, W. P. Couch, Survey No. 24, Block 330, 1280 acres, J. K. Hindman, Survey No. 768, Block 330, 640 acres, TCRyCo, and Survey No. 6, Block 362, 1280 acres, Virginia Parks, which are the several surveys in question, applied for by Mr. W. W. Burford.

You will run such connecting lines between well identified corners of surveys on the south to like corners of surveys in Blocks Nos. 23 and WJG2, on the north of the surveys above mentioned, so as to determine the extent of conflict, if any, in said surveys as indicated by the blue print copy of the official map of Presidio County sent you under separate cover. And report your findings to this office in your usual prompt manner.

For your assistance in making this survey, I am sending by mail under separate cover (in tube) a working sketch prepared from the field notes on file in this office of surveys and blocks of surveys covering the territory in question. Also a blue print copy of a part of the official map of ^{Presidio} Brewster County; blue print copy of sketch covering several blocks of the GH&SARyCo surveys, including Block No. 23, made by W. S. Mabry, State Surveyor, in May, 1889;
