Your letter of Oct. 18th. concerning field notes required ^{for} patenting land owned by Mr. R.E.L. Tyler in Presidio Co.

I am enclosing herewith field notes ask for in your letter of the 18th.

The records have been corrected on the field notes sent you by me on Oct. 14th.

I made a resurvey of section 24 block WJG9 and do not find where any excess land east and west nor north and south ^{exist} as claimed by Mr, Dodd. Also the north and south line of section 50 WJG-4 was rerun and carefully chained and did not find the 40 varas excess east and west nor the 60 varas north and south as shown on Dodds sketch.

Block WJG9 and WJG4 was originally surveyed by W.J.Glenn and the corners of WJG9 on the east line of this block are common with the sections on the west line of block WJG4. I have done a good deal of surveying in WJG9 and do not find any such excess exist north and south in this block.

Trusting this will complete the work of surveying necessary to enable Mr Tyler to get his land patented as he is very anxious to have this done as soon as possible.
