REPORT OF A CONNECTING LINE SURVEY OF A PORTION OF
PRESIDIO COUNTY, TEXAS, MADE FOR L.M.BENNETT AND J.V.SESSUMS,
BY R.E.MORRIS, STATE LICENSED LAND SURVEYOR, OF MARFA, TEXAS.

A connecting line survey made in the South central part of Presidio, County, said survey was begun in this area on June 29, 1945 for E.Howard to determine the location of of Block C-3, with chain carriers duly qualified, using a fifty vara chain where practical and checking the work by triangulation, using a standard Engineers transit properly in adjustment and running all lines to hub and tack point.

I began the survey by first locating the South line of Block 23, G.H.&S.A. Ry. Co. Then the South line of Block 8, H.&T.C.Ry. Co. Then run out surveys 9, 11 and 12 Block C-3 for E. Howard, tying this work into the North line of Block 1, D.&P. Ry. Co. at the West Southwest corner of survey No. 6, Block 362 on the North line of survey No. 92 Block 1, D.&P. Then on July 24, 1945 began the work for L.M.Bennett and J.V.Sessums at the South Southwest corner of survey 6, Block 362, checking on the Northeast corner of survey 89, Block 1, D.&P, then running the East line of said block to the Southeast corner of survey No. 22, where I found two corners, one a very old rock mound and the other a more recently constructed corner that apparently conforms to other corners found through-out said Block 1. The surveyor in setting these corners apparently started his work from the Southwest corner of the Louis Fuentes survey and constructed his corners to a pattern of 1900 varas through-out the block, leaving a short tier of surveys along the East of the block and some long surveys along the North line.

After running the East line of Block 1, D.&P., I then began at the Southwest corner of the Louis Fuentes survey and run East to the Southwest corner of League 1, Mitchell County School land, then tied this line into the East line of surveys 3 & 4 block 351 G.C.& S.F.Ry.Co. and run South to an old rock mound set for the Southeast corner of survey No. 7, Block 351, then run east and located two corners marked for the Southwest corner of League No. 2 Mitchell County School land. Then taking the corner that I thought to be the older of the two, then went to the West corner of survey No. 1 Block 9 H.& T.C.Ry Co. and run West to the Northwest corner of League 1, Mitchell County School land and found a very old rock mound for this corner and from this I located surveys 1, 2, 5, 6 and 8, Block 351 as is shown in my field notes and the accompanying plat also surveys 8, 10, 12 and 14, Block 362. Then begun at the Southwest corner of Louis Fuentes survey and run North 1339 varas to a corner set there for the Northwest corner of said Fuentes tract then West 3802.8 varas to a rock mound set for the Southwest corner of survey No. 16 Block 1 D.&P, the location of which was to the North of my line making a course of N.88°57'W from the original Southeast corner of survey No. 22 this block. Then run North from this point a distance of 15494.4 varas to the Northeast corner of survey No. 96 and tied this into the Southwest corner of survey No. 12 Block C-3, which was run South 2826 varas from the South line of survey No. 2 B.S.&F. said survey No. 2 being evidenced by well marked corners on the ground. The length of the East part of Block 1, being 15739.2 varas, the South line being 13260.3 varas and the North line being 13098.5 varas as evidenced by the location of surveys NO's 105 and 118 on the North and the Southwest corner of survey No 16 on the South, The Northeast corner of survey No. 89 and the Southeast corner of survey No. 22 Block 1, D.&P. also well defined and the Northeast corner of survey No. 93 as located by H.R.Gard is also on the ground. The surveys in the West part of Block 351 and the surveys South No's 17, 19 and 20 Block 1 D.&P. are marked on the ground by rock mounds as are indicated on the accompanying plat.

The survey in the 28 Block 1, D. & P. also well defined and the Northeast corner of survey 113 on the North and the Southwest corner of survey No. 12 on the Northeast corner of survey No. 89 and the Southwest corner of survey No. 1302. The survey as evidenced by the location of surveys No. 12 on the ground on the ground in the East part of Block 1, being 15439.3 No. 8 B. Dear Mr. Giles:-

On or about September 1 1945 I made a report of a ~~x~~ survey of several tracts of land in Blocks 1 D.&P.Ry.Co., Block 362 and Block 351.

Due to practically allotted time I submitted field notes that was not properly checked by the position occupied by other survey on the ground but since that time I have made a survey of Mitchell County School land Leagues 1 and 2, locating their corners on the East and checking them through to their corners on the West, which I found on the ground well marked, therefore changing surveys 2, 6, and 8 in Block 351, which also would change survey 12 and a small portion of survey 10, 14 and 16 of which I did not have occasion to submit field notes on the three later ones.

I begun the survey of the East line of survey 1 Mitchell County school land at a well marked stone mound in the South line of survey 1 Block 9 H.&T.C.Ry Co. which corner I showed on the plat of the survey I made of the land to the North and east in 1930 and thence South $0^{\circ}29'E$ to the Northwest corner of survey 5 Block 313 a distance of 748.8 varas, Thence continuing that line in all 5850.1 varas to an old rock mound marked M.C.l&2, and continuing in this line to 10815 varas to another old rock mound marked S.E.M.C.2; Thence S. $89^{\circ}23'W$. 5021.4 varas to another rock mound marked S.W.2 M.Co. Thence N. $0^{\circ}44'W$. at 4976.6 varas another old rock mound marked S.W.1 M.C. From this survey it was necessary to change the field notes on the above stated surveys, which I am herein submitting for your approval, and your record.
