Dear Sir:

Beginning at SE corner Survey 140, GH & SA Ry Co, Block 4, bearings found as represented on Working Sketch, traversing northward at 2755 vs. a small Rk. Md. on a high rocky East-West ridge; at 2785 vs. another, at 3805 vs., 2.0 vs. West of a large Rk Md, no marks found, but constructed similar to the Md. at SE 140, and apparently a corrected survey corner-NE 135, Blk. 4.

From this large Rk Md another large Rk Md, mkd NE 135, brs. S.50°33' W. 202 vs., and a 60d. spike in a small pile of rocks (by some former surveyor) brs. East 92 vs. Any reference to any part of Capote Mt. from either of these points is erroneous, unless of course, by calculation. No part of Capote Mt. is visible from this rincon, and no definite rim rock.

From unmarked Rk Md through spike in small rk md at 1914.6 varas, an old rock mound in edge of a flat, NE 136, Block 4, whence an iron pipe in N-S fence brs. East- 1190.6 vs.

At SW 140, GH & SA Ry Co, Block 4, we found the Rk Md described by Mr. Thee and others, 36 vs. West of Cedar Tree; in East line of Survey 4, Block 361, No mound or mark was found South-14 vs.; no mound or mark at lower SW corner of Sur. 4, Blk. 361.

Any reference to Small Hill in Valley, Brg. N.81°28'W. from vicinity of SW 4, Block 361, is erroneous. There is no valley to westward for several miles. A high cap-rock ridge blocks view to West. No mound or mark was found North 509 vs. from lower SW corner of Survey 4.

This N-S line crosses a series of ridges and canyons running eastward from Cap-rock ridge. Again it is entirely possible that some expert calculated bearing references for this corner in the same manner that another of the prominent young surveyors referenced Section and Mining Claim corners in South Brewster County a few years ago.
