Yours of the 12th inst., in reference to the resurvey of Section 17, Block 1, T. P. Ry. Co., in Randall County, has been received. The records of this office show that said section is partly in Randall County, which would give the County Surveyor of that county jurisdiction in matters of survey.

Mr. Foster appears to have made the resurvey and apportioned the excess in accordance with instructions previously given him by this office. He was instructed in apportioning excess in the block to respect as fer as possible the improvements placed upon their lands by the respective purchasers. To accomplish this purpose, which was unquestionably the right thing to do, the excess could not be equally distributed. In addition the symptry of the surveys composing the block had to be preserved. Mr. Foster's field notes have been approved and I do not think that the matter should now be reopened. I regret that any one owning land in this block should not be pleased with the result of the resurvey, but I think that the work as a whole is the best that could have been done under the citcumstances.
