Dear Commissioner:

Some weeks ago I requested of you a certificate of facts relative to Section 163, Block M-6, S. K. & K. in Randall County, Texas, which you furnished. I now ask that you furnish me another certificate of facts showing the same facts and any additional facts; for it is my understanding that Mr. W. D. Howren has filed field notes for your approval, and I wish the certificate of facts to show whether same have been approved.

Also, I wish to have your certificate of facts covering Sections 162, 164, 158 and 198, all in the same block.

If you will be good enough to refer to my letter asking for certificate of facts covering Section 163 which was written to you some weeks ago, you will be informed as to the circumstances, except that I simply must have your certificates by next Monday, November 30th; for sale of the land under deed of trust is now advertised for the first Tuesday in December, and there are many things to be done before that day.

Please get these certificates mailed to me not later than Saturday, November 28th, and wire me collect when you have mailed them. I do not like to ask such haste of you, but the owners of the land will lose it unless I can get these certificates from you by Monday, November 30th, 1931.

Dear Sir:

Under date of Nov 23rd., Mr W D Howren of your city, sent this department corrected field notes for section 163 Blk M-6 and on Nov 30th., I received a sketch bearing the name of "W D Howren, licensed land surveyor, Amarillo, Texas".

Your client, Mr Ross Green of Hereford, desires to have these field notes filed for the purpose of fixing the corners and boundaries of this tract. In my conversation with you over the phone, I advised that I had told Mr Howren when he was in the office recently that it would be well for the different owners in this block to get together and agree upon some plan of construction that they desired to have their corners placed acceptably to this department; also, if Mr Green wishes to file field notes, some statement from him should be furnished showing his acceptance of same as land out by the surveyor on the ground. *land*
