Dear Sir:

In making surveys of land in Reagan and Glascock Counties which is being patented by Mr. O. W. Matthews, as shown by accompanying maps, I began these surveys from the NW corner of Section 7, Block 2, T. & P. Railroad Company Survey. I found a mes. tree called for in the field notes which bears north  $62\frac{3}{4}$  degs. west 44 vrs. from said NW corner. I also found the stump for the other tree called for in the field notes which bears N.  $83\frac{1}{2}$  degs. west  $50\frac{1}{2}$  vrs. This stump stands about 3 feet above ground. I then ran a line E. with fence line on a variation of 11 degs. and find a pile of stone at the NE corner of 207 <sup>N.E. cor. of</sup> and 198 <sup>N.E. cor. of</sup> 183. I find that this gives me an excess of 24 vrs in this line. I put this excess in Section 14, Block O, T. P. R. R. Co. Survey. I then ran a line N. 2535 vrs. and located the NE corner of Section 14 as shown by accompany map in the West line of Section 174, T. P. R. R. Co. Survey. I then returned to NE. corner of 183 ran a line E. 1906 vrs, found a stone which is the SW corner of 186. I then ran a line E. 1906 vrs. and found a pile of stone ~~for~~ the SE corner of Block 156. I then ran a line N. look for corner at 1900 vrs, but found none. I then ran N. and found a stone lying on the ground marked NW 146. This stone, I am satisfied is the original corner of 146. The distance between the SE corner of 156 and the NW corner of 146 has an excess of 22 vrs in this line. I then ran a line E. 1906 vrs. and found some stones in an old fence line which ran south. I located this corner with a stake marked NE 146.

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Mr. J. T. Robinson - - - #2

I then went to the NE corner of Section 99, Block 2 T P R.R. Co. Survey, found a stone in the ground, but not marked. I then ran a line N. exactly 1200 vrs, found a stone marked NE BB the NE corner of Section 1, Brooks and Burleson Survey. I continued N. 1900 vrs<sup>in all</sup> found a stone marked SW 92, which I am satisfied is the original corner. ~~I also found a stone set by Mr. Kellis, Surveyor from Sterling City, marked SE 5 G. C. & S. E. This stone should be marked G. C. S. D.~~ I then ran a line N. 1900 vrs. found a stone marked NW 92 which is the NW corner of Section 92, Block 2, T. P.R. R. Co. I then returned to the NE corner of Section 99, ran a line E. 1902 vrs found a stone marked NE 90, the NE corner of Section 90. I then returned to the NE corner of 99, I ran a line W. at 1868 vrs. found a stone marked NE 118, the NE corner of Section 118, continued W. 3016 vrs<sup>in all</sup> set a corner, a stone, marked SW 1. I continued this line W. 1904 vrs. W. of the NE corner of 118, I find a large stone marked NW 118 and at 1883 vrs west of this stone is the corner set by me which I am satisfied is correct. I continued W. 4014 vrs<sup>from the stone I set marked "S.W. 1"</sup> & set a stone marked SW 2 BB. I then ran a line N. 900 vrs. set a stone marked SW C.T.M.C 2 & NW 2 BB. I then went to the SW corner of Section 45 Block 33, T. & P. R R Co. Survey, found a Mes. stump which bears N. 62 degs. W. 32 2/3 vrs I found another stump which bears S. 86 1/2 W. 42 vrs. I am satisfied that these are the stumps of the original bearing trees. I then placed a BO stake for corner marked NE 4. I then ran a line S. 1622 vrs. set a stone marked SE 1. I then ran a line W. 2743 vrs, set a pipe for the SW corner of Sec. 4 ~~xxx~~ G. B & C. R. R. Co. Survey and the Sw corner of Section 23 M. Gilmore Survey. I then returned to the NE corner of Sec. 4 ran a line S. 74 1/4 degs. W. at 1903 vrs. found a stone marked SW 44 at 2850 set a stake for NW corner of Sec. 4. I then ran a line

Sterling City, marked S. E. 5, G. C. & S. E. This stone should be marked G. C. S. D. K. G. N. G.

S.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs. W. 956 vrs. found a stone (not marked), which is the S<sub>w</sub> corner of Section 43 T. P R.R. the Se corner of Section 48 the NW corner of M. Gilmore and the NE corner of Sec. 15, Nancy Bohannon Survey. I then ran a line S.  $15\frac{1}{4}$  degs. E. 1911 vrs. found a stone marked SE 15. I then returned to the SW corner of Sec. 2, C. T. & M. C. R. R. Co. Survey, ran a line N. 788 vrs. set a stone for corner in the S. line of Sec. 4 G.B. & C. R. R. Co. Sur. marked NW.2, C. T. & M. C, and NE 17. I then ran a line E. 1412 vrs. set a stone marked NE 2 and NW 1 C.T. & ~~MC~~ ~~xxxxxx~~ Co. I then returned to the NE corner of Sec 15, Nancy Bohannon, ran a line S.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs. W. at 1903 vrs found a stone marked the SW 47. This stone should be marked SE 47 or SW 48 At 3806 vrs found a stone marked NW 15. I then ran a line S.  $15\frac{1}{4}$  degs E. looked for the SW corner of sur. 15 Nancy Bohannon, but found none. I returned to the NW cor. of Sec. 15, Nancy Bohannon, ran a line S.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs W. 1903 vrs. set a stake in fence line which ran N.  $15\frac{3}{4}$  degs. west. I then ran a line S.  $15\frac{3}{4}$  degs. E 1911 vrs. set a stake for SE corner of Sec. 2, and SW corner of Sec. 1. G. C. & S. R.R. Co. Survey, Block A. I then ran a line N.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs. E. 71 vrs. set a stake for the NW. corner of Sec. 16, Nancy Bohannon and the NE corner of the E. part of Sec. 18, S.H. Birdwell Survey. I then ran a line S. 191 vrs. set a stake in the N. line of Sec. 13, T.C.R. R. Co. Sur. for the Sw corner of Sec. 16. I then returned to the NE corner of Sec. 2, T C. & S.F.R.R. Survey, ran a line S.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs W. 1903 vrs. set a stake for corner in a fence which ran N.  $15\frac{3}{4}$  degs. W. I then ran S. with fence line  $15\frac{3}{4}$  degs. E. (e) 1911 vrs. ~~xxxxxx~~ set a stake for SW corner of 2. I then ran a line N.  $74\frac{1}{4}$  degs W. 290 vrs. set a stake for NW corner of Sec. 12, T. C. R. R. Co. Survey. I then ran a line S. 2269 vrs. to the SW corner of Sec. 12.

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
