Robison, Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter dated June 27th., 1913, signed D.D.Thompson, who represents himself as Chairman of the Real County Commissioners, to designate the geographical center of Real County, do hereby certify that I have from the maps, surveys and other data on file in this office, and from the boundaries of Real County, as contained in the Act creating said County, approved April, 3rd., 1913, ascertained the geographical center of said county, and do hereby certify that the geographical center of Real County is a point within the limits of Survey No.29, Certificate 0/79, Block No.3, T. W. N. G. Ry. Co., on the present official map of Edwards County, 800 varas South and 150 varas West from the N.E.corner of said Survey No.29.

To the Honorable District Court of Edwards County:

In compliance with an order of your court at the May term 1904 in which I was appointed to make a survey of Surveys 9 and 10 Columbia Top. Ry. Co. or of as much as is necessary to actually establish the true line between said Surveys 9 and 10 I respectfully submit the following report with attached plat which was made by me from work actually done by me on the ground;

I began work Sept. 30th 1904 at the S.E. cor. of Sur. 9- Columbia Top. Ry. Co. from which a L.O. 14 " marked $\circ \begin{array}{c} \text{||||} \\ \text{||||} \end{array} \circ$ (8 hacks with blaze on each side of hacks) brs. S 59 W. 27 vrs.- a sp. o. stump 12 " brs. N 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 15 vrs. from this corner a point on West side of Frio River brs. S 70 W. 525 vrs. and from said point a L.O. 10 " marked $\begin{array}{c} \text{|||} \\ \text{X} \\ \text{|||} \end{array}$ brs. N 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10 $\frac{1}{5}$ vrs. I ran N 20 W 1000 vrs. the E. bank of Frio 1900 vrs. from said S.E. cor. No. 9 to a point on high hill. Thence N 70 E. 441 vrs. to a point 45 vrs. S 70 W. from West bank of Frio river (from this point the S.E. cor. of No. 9 brs. S 7 E. 1950 vrs. (and running S 7 E at 620 vrs. the West bank of Frio river). Thence N 20 W. at 123 vrs. the West bank of Frio river, crossing river- at 1615 vrs. the East bank of river-crossing river again-in all 2020 vrs. Thence N 70 E. 1695 vrs. to st. md. on West bank of Frio river from which a sp. o. 20 " marked $\begin{array}{c} \text{||} \\ \text{O} \\ \text{||} \end{array}$ brs. N 29 W. 4 vrs.- a white o. stump 14 " brs. S 88 E. 17 vrs. to continue on a course of N 20 W. from point marked " on a high hill" on attached plat. to North North lines of Surveys 12 and 11 river will not be crossed. to run from point 45 vrs. from West bank of River will cross river twice
