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Dear Sir: Answering requests in copy of General Land Office letter to Mr. S. J. White of Leakey, Texas, dated August 7th, 1931, beg to submit further data on location and marks of original copners identified on surveys lying along Real-Uvalde county line as follows:

folloThe L. O. brg. scalled for as witness to S. E. corner survey No. 1037 is marked X.

The Cedar 15" dfa. a witness tree to S. E. corner survey No. 850.2, as described in field notes of Mr. J. Chism in survey made by him on Oct. 16th, 1911, is makred X. The 5" white oak called for here is dead and fallen with no marks visible. The witness trees found at N. W. corner survey No. 850.2, a cedar 8" W. 8 VBS. Do. 6" S. 64-30' E. 7.5 vrs. are marked X, and stand true to call in field notes. See fourth paragraph of Tetter to General Land Office dated 3/16/31 describing S. W. corner of survey No. 1037. The corner there described can be no other than the original S.W. corner of survey No. 1037.

The N. W. corner survey No. 852 calls for two witness trees, a Pin oak 12" S. 88-30' E. W.4 vrs. and a Cedar 12" S. 21-45' W. 19 vrs. Both trees are marked X and stand true to their call.

Witness trees for the N. E. Corner of survey No. 861, Whitlock, P. O. 4" S. 82-45' E. 1.6 vrs. and dp, 4" S. 26-45' W. 4 vrs. Both trees marked o and stand true to call.

In connection with field work of August 16th to 21st. following instructions of General Land Office letter of August 7th to S. J. White, a copy of which wassent to my adress, the following data: I checked again the south lines of surveys Nos. 1037 and 1038 with no change in results. Running north from rock mound, the S.W. corner No. 1038 as determined on previous surveying, I located rk. md. and fence corner 1900 vrs. north; this point being 80 vrs. N. of the center of Cherry creek for N. E. corner survey No. 1043, at 2418 vrs. found rk. md. in deep ravine, a short steep header leading into Blanket creek. This fits the call in field notes for S. W. corner survey No. 1040. From this rk. md. I ran a line north which line follows the bed of Blanket creek, upstream, for 800 vrs. then crosses divide, and at 1040 enters short drain leading into main drain, a tributary of the Sabinal River.

Set up over rk. md. the original S. W. corner\_of survey Np. 615. Here found SP. Oak 4" N. 50 W. 7.2 vrs. mkd. X and Sp. O. 3" N. 54 W. 9.2 vrs. (tree dead and fallen) Thence ran line north 16 degrees west 2688 vrs. to stake and rk. md. for N. W. corner and S. W. corner survey No. 853; thence N. 74 E. at 1061, west bank of Blanket creek, at 1344 vrs. -- bearing trees called for here as designation point on south line of survey No. 853 are gone, there being a field in cultivation at this point, at 1811 vrs. W. bank of creek or drain. The call on south line 853, viz:" at 1838 enter branch, at 1888 E. bank of creek, at 1918 crossed branch again."

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can be accurately located along this line, but will cause conflict with survey No. 615 by about 75 vrs.

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Also ran line N. 74 E. from S. W. corner No. 615 as above described and at 1369 vrs. found rk. md., the N. E. and N. W. corner of surveys Nos. 235 and 237 respectively, fr. wh. a Cedar 10" dia. brs. S. 86 E. 37.2 vrs. and a L. O. 18" dda. brs. N. 43-30' E. 228 vrs. Both trees marked X., continued N. 74 E. and at 2729 vrs. found rk. md. on east slope of hill, the original S. E. corner survey No. 615, a cedar 10" S. 86 E. 37.2 vrs. do. 7" dia. N. 65 E. 37.3 vrs. both trees mkd. X and stand true to call. thenceran line N. 16 W. -- bearing trees called for along this line as designation point not found, at 2608 vrs. found rk. md. on north slope of mtm. fr. wh. a cedar 5" brs. S. 19 E. 3.4 vrs. tree mkd. X. Pin Oak 8" N. 76 E. 2.2 vrs. now dead and lying on ground. This corner too far south and will conflict by 80 vrs. along north line of 615.

Set up on rk. md. the N. W. corner survey No. 852, -N. 1/2and ran line S. 16 E. intersecting north line of survey No. 615, This line measures 850 vrs. and intersects north line 615 distant, 352 vrs. S. 74 W. from the N. E. corner of survey No. 615.

Beginning at a rk./ md. the S. S. corner survey No. 854, in west line survey No. 615, at 232 vrs. bass the N. W. corner of survey No. 615, 1344 vrs, set rk. md. for the N. W. corner of survey No 853 and N. E. corner No. 854. in south line survey No. 853 1/4, Cude. thence south 74 west 1344 vrs. and set rk. md. for N. W. corner 854 and an interior corner of survey No. 854.5.

From N."E. corner survey No. 853 ran line north and intersected at 153 vrs. the south boundary line of survey No. 1066, T. C. Ry. Co.

Located the N. E corner of survey No. 260 S. E. Felts, a rk. md. in low Mtn. Pass fr. wh. a rk. bluff in head of small ravine brs. S. 29 W. 10 vrs. Sp. 0. 10" S. 30.6 vrs. Found bearing tree fallen and rotted marked young tree 8" dia. grown out of old root system S. 30.8 vrs. X. Round Mtn. pinnacle brs. S. 12 W. 80 vrs. and the S. W. corner of survey No. 1066 brs. S. 77-5' E. 443 vrs. From this point ran line south 20 west 950 vrs. for S. E. corner survey No. 260 found line to terminate in field and bearings grubbed out. Thence west and at 400 vrs. crossed Cherry creek. At a point in east line survey No. 260, 400 vrs. N. 20 E. from its S. E. corner looked for bearing trees called for in field notes of survey No. 892, but found nothing as fire has destroyed all old timber. Located N. E. corner survey No. 891, a Sp. 0. stump on west bank of creek for corner fr. wh. a Sp. 0. 10" brs. S. 17 E. 19 vrs. Hull of bearing tree only remaining and a cluster of Saplings grown out of old root system. From said Sp. O. stump on west bank of creek, I ran a line N. 70 W. for north line survey No. 891, and at 581 vrs. intersected east line of survey No. 260 distant 579 vrs. S. 20 W. of its N. E. corner.

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From N. E. corner survey No. 891 ran a line S. 20 W. 321 vrs. and set rk. md. for N. W. corner survey No. 892, thence east 587 vrs. to intersect with west boundary line of survey No. 854, which point of intersection is distant 435 vrs. S. 16 E. of the N. W. corner survey No. 854.
