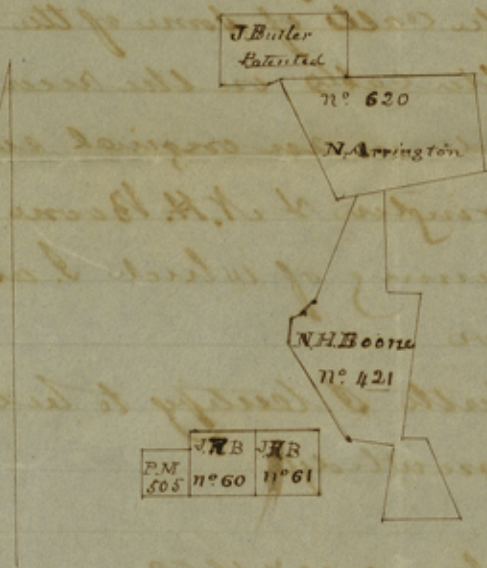


Connection of Surveys



The surveys of land above, represented by the map, is made out to make a connection of the surveys of Jacob H. Boone and John R. Boone, with a survey of 616 acres made for John Butler which tract of land has been patented, and is situated about one and a half miles south of Clarksville.

The N. W. corner of Noel Arringtons being at one of Butlers middle corners and 1378 or West of said Butlers S. E. corner. I shall here set down the courses and distances on the Arrington & Boone lines to make this connection as I find them by actual survey viz. Arrington N° 620 from its N. W. corner to Butlers line runs S 24° E. 2720 varas N 81° E 400 or to N.H. Boones N. W. Corner then with Boones line S 24° W 2260. S 46° W 410, S 55° W 190. S 11° W 570 S 30° E. 2300 or from this corner of Boone Needham H. Boone, the North East corner of Jacob H. Boone, 320 acre survey, stands 602 varas West; and 204 varas North, or the North East corner of the John R. Boones Survey is S 9° E 7472 ⁷¹¹⁷ or from Arringtons N. W. Corner on Butlers corner S 4° 46' E 7143 varas according to my calculation N. H. Boone.

The survey marked P.M. 505. is a labor in the name of P. D. Midkiff. Jacob H. Boone N° 60. Survey of 320 acres lying on the East of Midkiff. John R. Boone N° 61. a survey of 320 acres lying East of Jacob H. Boone, the N E corner of which reaches Eastward within 602 or West and 204 or
