The NW corner of James McCreary, 181 ac. tract
is 1158' vs East, and 983' South of the SW corner of
his 459 ac. survey. Anthony Colby begins E.B. tract of
the 459 ac. & the SW corner is 345' North of its S.E. corner
and is a square of 400 ac. as represented

24 Ben Hals 160 ac. lies across the county line & his S.E. corner
is 143' East of the line. James McCreary lies along the
county line 1033' & its S.W. corner is 119' East of the S.W. corner
of a survey of 320 ac. in the name of William Brown
as the Record shows, its S.W. corner by the call is just 100' East
West of John W. Bland's S.W. corner.
The John W. Bland, the Patsy Kitchens corner with A.B. Kings
ferry tract, & the place Sulphur in straight place

The S.E. corner of J.M. Harmon's survey
is 4400' North of Preston Bland's S.E. corner
& Bank of the sulphur. Preston Bland's survey for
the S.E. corner is 1437' N. & 613' East of
Bland's S.E. corner. Randolph Church's S.E. corner 4634'
West and 535' S. of McCreary's S.W. corner. John Country
James Church's S.E. corner is 273' N. E. of Church's S.E. corner and his survey
extends to sulphur. The survey of Hollingworth & Bays are shown
to connect with Harmon's

Not located begins 1224' N. & 345' West of Ben Perle's 780 ac.
and by the map unless the Mason's survey represents 90' N. & 160' W.
but the Mason's survey is void, the other half also which was
laid on Ben's bank, all of which I know when I run lines
out, having heard the owner (B. Perle) say so, hence I
called to begin the Mason's survey from Perle's S.E. corner
