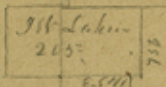
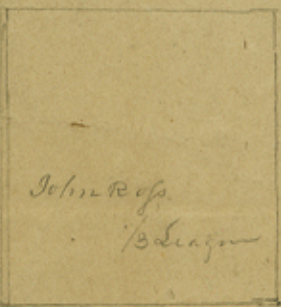
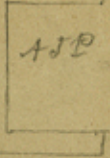
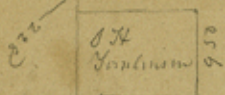
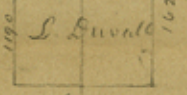


City line

Although in much pain from bodily affliction I furnish you a sketch of the past required from the St. Sebastian survey along the by line to the John Rop survey, though imperfect and roughly done it is correct as to the distance showing at different periods measured every line, as they are stated in the distance.
