


A sketch showing the connection of the surveys on the east side of

Now let me show the facts as they appear upon the ground the E. line of the
Miro from the record is only 6037, McCollett going 613 further N. - all the northings on

I have never yet been able to find any proper S.E.C. the distances fall out in such a manner that
much undergives a tenth part on the ground. I found two pieces of paper in the office of 1854 but
they were abandoned. They sat at Mr. Mc. Wc. 3100 So. for 2. as 1900 is 1. Then I made the French
Survey of 1853. At the time of the Mico gave it as his opinion that the distance named by Mr. Y. H.
was the proper one but as I could find nothing to corroborate him so I believed there was
an error, and this is the reason why I in making the French's work made the point of
beginning at French's S.W.C. and give as the map shows. Now I have measured all of the land
the Mico line to see once and certify has the distance given on the French's map is correct, and
that there is no conflict on the ground with the Survey of Smith or French's. I made the Survey
of John Deakins and W. G. Smith under the Act of 1860 French's being made before. Section No. 950
Smith's No. 1113 French's 930 - making from N.E. S.W.C. 2998 leaving 802. to complete the
line call of 3800... Your Map of the Mico Land, if you photograph it comes does not the fact

all the while that there was error in this Survey, and is one reason they failed to comply

no Survey made on the 1/3 of the Mico claim. There is no error or conflict with the
Survey I performed except French's call in saying 7000 N. of Mico S.E.C. which was
caused by the want of acknowledgement of the facts, as none was visible, by which I
should have ^{been} governed. I hold, that the P. Comptroller may set up it, as not well
defined boundaries. Compare then these surveys, then distances with the line from
from Mr. S.W.C., the error in the Map will be manifest.
