Enclosed I furnish you statement showing the surroundings & connections of the John Price Survey on Blossom Prairie about 15 miles South West from Clarksville

In December when the time for locating certificates was drawing to a close, when the business of my office was so pressing that I had hardly time to examine field notes made by my deputies there were forwarded several surveys out in name of D. C. Parkey north of the J. K. Rodgers between the Price & Rodgers, also one made South of Price & north of D. D. Benton & Scoville both of said surveys are evidently incorrect as the lines all close up leaving no vacant land in this section of country there is however a small strip of vacant

Land between the Leavitt & Isaac
Wilson Survey - There is also a
vacancy of 205 Acres North of
the John Price which has been
Surveyed and returned -
