Dear Sir - I beg to submit a rough sketch of surveys from Sulphur S.P. of Red River County, to the surveys immediately bordering on the reservation line of on south side of Rail Road. This Reserve line has been located at various points according to surveys made on the North or South of said supposed line. I have recently been over most of these surveys from the N. P. on Sulphur to the Sec. S. Young on the N. side of Cuthard Creek and find the measurements to correspond with the within enclosed map we have had heretofore some rather wild surveying in this section, and I find the map sent out from your office recently correct in most instances. I desire to call your Draughtsmans attention to the fact that the Mary F. McConnick survey is in error. there is no vacancy between the E. Sharp and D. Perkins surveys and of course cannot embrace the vacancy in the swamps on the N. of the Perkins - see. 27. N. & P. R.R. Co. Beginning at S.W. corner of Jas Chute running S. 1500. vs. and thence with the Reserve line

measurement several times on the ground and I am fully
satisfied that the Reserve line at this point as shown by
my map is properly located.

no assistance there will no harm be done.
