

Survey for Jose and Juan De La Garza
and Jose Vidauri of 56,678, 182. Sq. varas,
situated on the south bank of the San An-
tonio River opposite Carlos's Rancho; being
a part of the quantity of land to which
they are entitled by virtue of a title from
the Mexican Government, dated October 15th
1834, and by them transferred to L. Colqu-
houn, on the 13th. May 1839, and re-sur-
veyed in accordance with an act of Congress,
Approved the 1st. February 1845.

Beginning at the N.E. Corner of a
survey in the name of Power and Hewitson
on the right bank of the San Antonio River, for
the N.W. Corner of this survey, from which an
Elm, marked *I*, bears $S 80^{\circ} W$. 250. var. also a Hack-
berry *g*. In. diam. marked *C*. bears South $6^{\circ} W$. 8.

Thence with the meanders of said river
East 80. var. $S 45^{\circ} E$. 500. var. $N 45^{\circ} E$. 1600. var. N .
 $80^{\circ} E$. 700. var. South 500. var. $S 50^{\circ} E$. 400. var. South
400. var. South 200. var. East 638. var. $S 74^{\circ} E$. 180.
var. $S 40^{\circ} E$. 280. var. $S 76^{\circ} E$. 247. var. to the
N.W. Corner of a survey in the name of
Power & Hewitson for the N.E. Corner of this
from which a Boxelder marked *I*, bears S .
 $18^{\circ} W$. 6. var. also a Sycamore marked *C*.
