

Report of the County Surveyor of Refugio County, of a survey made for J.C. Dilworth, owner of ~~the~~ Certificate No. 49, issued to the Canutillo Ditch Company, now on file in the General Land Office, having been filed on that particular tract of land in Refugio County known as Bickford's Bend, on the San Antonio River, and between the said River and the Brichta survey.

Said survey was made on the 22 day of Nov., 1902, in accordance with instructions from the General Land Office, given through Messrs FLY & HILL, Attornies for the said Dilworth, in which they were requested to have a survey made, connecting the corner of the Peter Hynes League as fixed by the Supreme Court in the case of Withers Vs. O'Connor 76 Texas, p 185, and the lower corner, on the River, of the Robertson League.

In accordance with the said instructions, I proceeded to the stone, called for in the said opinion as the corner of the Peter Hynes League.

From this stone, which is well known, I ran, the width of the 5 Leagues, granted to Joshua Davis, and afterwards cancelled, giving each League its full call of 1666-2/3 varas, or an aggregate distance of 8333-1/3 varas, for the lower line of the Joshua Davis 1/4 League.

Having thus determined the location of the lower line of the said 1/4 League I ran it in to the River.

I then ran at right angles to the last named line 416-2/3 varas the width of the said 1/4 League, and thus determined its upper line.

From the upper line of the said 1/4 League as thus established I meandered the river to the lowest point on the bend of the river, as follows; to wit:

S 29 E. 115 S 34 E 60 vrs. to the N.W. Cor. of said Joshua Davis as has been claimed for nearly five years or more. N 50 E 80 vrs N 16 3/4 E. 70 N 68 3/4 E

212 vrs. N 52 1/2 E, 140 N 9 1/4 E, 177 S 78 E. 67 S 50 E 110

N 63 E 60 N 28 E. 80 N 12 E. 66 N 0 E. 71 N 28 W 88. N 40 1/2 W. 60 N 30 1/2

180 vrs to a point 75 vrs. above mouth of branch called for in the field notes of the Francis Brichta Sur.

I then proceeded to the ~~lower~~^{upper} corner (on the river) of the Robertson League

which is marked by an old bearing tree

thence S 14 W. with the West line of said

Robertson - thence S 76 E. 32048 vrs

to the West line of said Joshua Davis
1/4 League grant as fixed by my sur. above
mentioned which line is 134 no. N 76 W. of
said line as now and has been rec-
ognized for 25 or more years.

Both the upper and lower limbs as recog-
nized have been found for over 26 years.
