Dear Sir:

At the hearing before the Land Board this morning I stated that from the data contained in my report, filed in behalf of Hewit & Dougherty, a mathematical calculation would show the point above the mouth of Willow Creek to which it retains an average width of 30 feet or more.

According to my calculation the point would be at Station 123+00 varas, which is 14,950 varas above the mouth of the creek, according to its meanders. This is approximately midway between the upper and lower lines of the Jose Maria y Gregorio Cobian Grant. This point is about 300 varas upstream from the East boundary of Hewit & Dougherty's Rooke lease and about 2,950 varas downstream from the East boundary of their Roche lease.

Measuring from the mouth up, the creek bed does not retain an average width of as much as 30 feet beyond or above the point so designated and described.

In making this computation I have used the figures shown on my report representing the width between vegetation lines, since they seem to me to demark the cut bank, or to describe a width greater than the cut bank.
