

Austin Texas Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 1882

I Jno. W. Maddox, Deputy Surveyor of  
 Clear Land District do hereby certify  
 that in making certain surveys for  
 Gunter Munson in Roberts Co. Texas a  
 sketch of which was filed this day in  
 the Gen. Land Office that connections  
 were made with the surveys in Block  
 B. 1 for A. M. R. R. Co. Block A:  
 2 for I. M. R. R. Co. on the South the  
 original corners of several surveys along  
 the N. lines of each block being found  
 and identified. The original corners of  
 the 320 acre surveys in Block A- A 2  
 A. 5<sup>th</sup> & 5 were found and identified.  
 Also the S. W. corner of Survey # 221<sup>st</sup>  
 N. W. of 222 in Block A 4<sup>th</sup> for  
 S. C. R. R. Co. was found and identified  
 by its bearing trees. The N. E. corner  
 of Survey # 1 in Block A. for E. L. R. R.  
 R. R. Co. was found to be 142 rods N.  
 and same distance W. from the N. W.  
 corner of Survey # 6 for P. S. and A. said  
 survey # 6 being fixed by a direct connection  
 with well identified corners in Block B. 1  
 for H. C. R. R. Co.

The locations given to Block A- A. 2.  
 A. 5<sup>th</sup> and the 320 acre survey in Block D  
 and that given Block 42 for S. C. R. R. Co.  
 on the sketch and by the field notes returned  
 by me are their true locations with  
 reference to each other and the I. M. R. R.  
 blocks on the South as ascertained

by connections made on the ground  
between well identified corners.

The ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> H. & N. R.R. Co. surveys on N. side of  
Canadian River in Block A. were fixed by  
giving the W. lines of each survey <sup>and</sup> the  
N. line of each the length called for in  
field notes unless shown to be otherwise  
by well identified bearing trees <sup>no</sup> letting  
all surveys front on river though the  
meanders given in field notes of those  
surveys do not in any case fit the river.  
No corners, marks nor any kind of ident-  
ification could be found on South side  
of river to fix the surveys in Block 46  
for H. & N. R.R. Co. <sup>no</sup> in making Match  
they were each fronted on river <sup>and</sup> given  
width called for <sup>and</sup> the W. lines length  
called for through the calls in field  
notes were in no case satisfied by  
this arrangement.

where they should be placed under  
their field notes is a matter of doubt.
