Runnels County } of a connecting line from
the N.W. Corner of the Thomas M. Fowler league
survey, on the waters of Valley Creek to the N.E.
Corner of Survey No 50 in Block No 63 of the N. T.
& B. R. R. Co, on the waters of Coyote Creek, about
14 miles north of Ballinger in Runnels County.

Begin at a Rock Mound in a wire fence, 24
varas south of the N.E. Corner of Bradfords field, this
rock mound being the recognized N.W. Corner of the
Thomas M. Fowler league survey, from which two
mesquites, nearly in line bear N 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ W, one 324 varas
(stepped) and the other 328 varas, distant.

Thence East, with north line of said Fowler
survey, at 1000 varas a slough, at 1800 varas
Valley Creek, course S.S.E., at 2320 varas S.W. Corner
of wire fence, at 4143 varas S.E. corner same wire
fence, at 4896 varas a rock mound for the N.E.
corner of said Fowler survey, seven varas west
of a wire fence running north and south.

Thence North, at 345 varas a wire fence run-
ning east and west, at 360 varas a rock mound
for the north line of ~~of~~ Survey 48 in said Block 63.

Thence East, with north line of said survey 48,
at 196 varas wire fence running north, at 1158 varas
a Rock Mound, the N.W. Corner of survey 49 in
said Block 63, from which point a line run S.
will cross a branch at 500 varas, but no bearing
tree was found, this point 17 varas N of E+W wire fence.

Thence East, with north line of said survey 49,
at 459 varas a wire fence run north, at 1912

varas, a rock mound in said E. + W. wire fence, the N.W. Corner of Survey 50 in said Block 63, from which a large old Mesquite stump bears S 99° W 94^{varas}.

Thence East, with north line of said Survey 50, at 1280 Coyote Creek (course south), at 1601 varas same, at 1695 varas same, at 1900 varas a rock mound in wire fence ~~at~~ running E. + W, at intersection with another running north, this is the N.E. corner of said Survey 50, from which a bunch of Willows bear N 70 W, another bear N 58 W, another N 46½ W, distances not measured because the trees were across a wide lagoon, but the distances appear to be as called for in field notes of Sur 50.

Thence South, with east line of said Survey 50 at 460 varas Coyote Cr, course east.
