This Survey closed N & S within 0.32' and E & W 4.47'. The total error of closure was 1 in 7202: The courses and distances were not adjusted to close the survey exactly, since that would not show the actual distances and bearings read in the field.

The bearings were controlled by taking two sets of solar observations at nine different points on line and averaging these observations to obtain the true courses. Other bearings were obtained by deflection angles from the solar lines.

All chaining was done by 200' steel tape using spring balance and supported on ground slopes. Horizontal distances were obtained by reducing the slope distance to horizontal from slope angles obtained by clinometer readings. Bearing trees were tied in to monuments with Brunton Compass and 50' tape.

Latitude observations were made by transit at noon. Longitude was obtained by scaling from a Government P. O. Map.

Corners were identified by old residents, and these corners were weighted as to evidence.

The accompanying map shows the land lines as found in the field and the Boundary as final-ly surveyed and marked on the ground with concrete monuments having a numbered aluminum top plate set in the concrete monument. Numbers are stamped in with steel die.
