

Although there is writing on the backs of these two pieces of paper, I think that was not intended to be seen. I think that those sides were used paper that were glued or pasted together to make one piece of paper with two clean sides. (Notice ^{lower} the yellowish stains between the sheets that may indicate where glue was spread to hold them together).

Therefore, do not try to separate the two pieces of paper.
