REPORT OF SURVEY OF 925 acres, more or less, in San Augustine County, Texas, made by W. C. Huntington, State Licensed Surveyor, originally made for Jesse Burditt by Ira Ellis in October, 1841.

In making the corrected survey of the Jesse Burditt in said county, I found that the Sam Crain Survey as patented in 1901, conflicts with the Original survey made for Jessie Burditt by Ira Ellis in 1841. I found the original Southwest corner of the Sam Crain, and identified two of the bearing trees called for in the Sam Crain patent. I then ran with an old line S. 89 deg. E. 333 vrs. and found no bearing trees called for in the Crain patent, but there was an old line running North from ~~xxx~~ ^{this} point; The Crain patent field notes call ~~for~~ the Southwest corner of the Crain as being the same corner as the North West corner of the John C. Smith Survey, and the Southeast Corner of the A. M. Davidson Survey; The total distance from the Southwest corner of the Crain Survey to the Northeast corner of the William Kimbre Survey is 1177 vrs; In the old Smith (John C.) patent field notes the Burditt corner was called at 706 vrs. from the NE corner of the Smith, and in comparing the distances of North line of the William Kimbre, which calls for 270 vrs. and the Smith which calls for 903 vrs., which is a total distance of 1173 vrs. to the Northwest corner of the John C. Smith; in the Ira Ellis field notes, the Burditt Survey calls for 980 vrs. from the NorthEast corner of the William Kimbre to the 8th corner of the Burditt Survey, which conflicts with the Crain Survey as now established on the ground to extent of 136 varas, and since the Crain/^{East}line is well established on the ground, I stopped the Bruditt Survey at a point 333 vrs. S. 89 E. from the Southwest Corner of the ~~xxx~~ Sam Crain Survey, which was identified on the ground.

From the above facts and conditions, this accounts for the decrease in acreage of the original survey made for Jesse Burditt by Irax Ellis.
