

REPORT OF SURVEY OF JESSE B. IRVINE.

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In making a resurvey of the Jesse B. Irvine survey, Abstract No. 177, in San Jacinto County, Texas, I began the survey at the old commonly recognized north east corner of the J.T. Simpson league on the west bank of the Trinity River, I found an iron stake for corner.

I then run N $89\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W following old hacked line at about 100 vrs old pecan 36 in in dia hacked on the north, at about 180 vrs sweet gum 26 in in dia hacked on the North, at 240 edge of pond which is 80 vrs wide, my chainmen waded this pond to insure careful measurement, at 518 vrs old rail road iron set on right of way line of H.E & W.T.R.R., at 567 vrs old rail road iron set on West right of way line of said rail road;

These rail road irons mentioned above were set on all original survey lines by the rail road engineers at an early date.

I continued my line N $89\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W and set stake in a field;

I then went to the old north east corner of the J.A. Schnell survey and run east 220 vrs to locate the south east corner of the S.S. Lanier survey. This I did by finding a stump hole and section of a post oak tree which stump hole corresponded to the original bearing tree for the south east corner of the S.S. Lanier survey, which was a post oak 10 in in dia brs N 7° W $2\frac{1}{2}$ vrs. The stump hole fits this call for the south east corner of the Lanier survey. I made new bearing trees at this point and also called for the sump hole all of which are described in my field notes covering the resurvey of the said Irvine survey.

I then run east along the north line of the Annie J. Smith survey 675 vrs to the north east corner of this survey on the west line of the J.T. Simpson league, and adopted this north east corner for a corner of the J.B. Irvine survey.

I then run N $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E with the west line of the J.J. Simpson survey 2393 vrs to where it intersected the first line I run from the Trinity River for the north line of the J.T. Simpson and made

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corner in a field for the north west corner of the Simpson league, an intrant corner of the J.B.Irvine survey. This corner is N $89 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 3062 vrs from the north east corner of the Simpson league on the Trinity River, my beginning corner.

I then went to the south east corner of the S.S.Lanier as established by me and run north at about 80 vrs old post oak side hacked on the east at 2500 vrs the distance called for the east line of the S.S.Lanier and made corner for the north east corner of the S.S.Lanier on south line of the J.D.Martinez league No.10 in a pasture. This location gives me the north west corner of the J.B.Irvine.

I then run N 89° E with the south line of said Martinez league No.10 a distance of 3647 vrs to the west bank of the Trinity River for the south east corner of said league No.10 and the north east corner of the J.B.Irvine survey.

I then measured down the river to the beginning.
